PHIL. K. GORDON GIVEN MERITED PROMOTION

Son-In-Law of Colonel Masten Becomes General Agent of Several Lines.

Announcement is made by Traffic Manager C. K. Dunlap, of the Galveston, Harrisburg & San Antonio Railway (The Sunset Route), of the appointment of Phil K. Gordon as General Agent of the Passenger Department for the Pacific coast of that line and to represent the Southern Pacific Company's lines in Louisiana, the M. L. & T. Railway and the Atlantic Steamship Lines of the Southern Pacific Company, effective September 1. Mr. Gordon has for the past seven years represented the Washington-Sunset Route as Pacific Coast Passenger agent, which organization he leaves to form a new organization representing the lines stated.

Mr. Gordon's services began in 1886 under General T. H. Goodman of the Southern Pacific Company. For five years he represented the Canadian Pacific Railway and Steamship lines in San Francisco and in 1900 was appointed by E. O. McCormick as City Passenger Agent of the Southern Pacific Company and had charge of the trans-pacific and military business during the Spanish-American war movement. He is a son of General David S. Gordon, U. S. A. army retired, now living in San Francisco.

New agencies will likely be created at San Francisco and Los Angeles to care for the Sunset Route business under Gordon's direction.

Mr. Gordon, in the railway world, has the reputation of being one of the smartest passenger men in the United States. He has a host of friends in Phoenix, being well-known in this section owing to his having married the daughter of Colonel Masten, former owner of the Maricopa & Phoenix Railway.

MORITZ APPOINTED ASSISTANT SECRETARY

Fred Cleveland Will Continue as Secretary to the Governor at Least Until the Constitutional Convention Meets.

A. G. Moritz has accepted the position of assistant secretary to Governor Sloan. Mr. Moritz has been with the National Bank of Arizona during the past year.

Secretary Fred Cleveland will still continue in the executive office in a supervisory capacity at least until after the constitutional convention. Governor Sloan has asked him to remain as his secretary as long as he can without conflicting with his duties as cashier of the Union Bank & Trust company—a position which he accepted last spring. When Judge Sloan was appointed to the office of governor he retained Fred Cleveland who was Governor Kibbey's secretary. There is a great deal of detail work that has to be performed in the executive office and a certain familiarity with it is essentially a part of the secretary's business. A change in this office is naturally dreaded and Governor Sloan requested Cleveland to remain in office during the remainder of his term, or until Arizona is admitted as a state. Mr. Moritz will act as his assistant. He is a young man who came to Arizona about two years ago and was first employed in the office of Judge Armstrong. After that he joined the force of the Arizona National bank and has been with that institution about a year. Mr. Moritz started in with his work at the capital yesterday morning.
