[Republican A. P. Leased Wire] WASHINGTON, Aug. 31.—The text of the Adamson bill follows: "Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress Assembled: Section 1.—That beginning December 1, 1916, eight hours shall be the normal day's work...
