Attorney General Moody Is Investigating Telegraphers' Strike On Great Northern MAY SETTLE BY ARBITRATION

Attorney General Moody has determined to investigate the extent to which the government's business is interfered with by the strike of telegraphers on the Great Northern and Northern Pacific systems.
