H. Merritt and E. H. Dunbar, for the pur-pose of enforcing their several mechanic's liens heretofore filed and recorded in the office of the probate clerk of said county, amounting altogether to the sum of \$1,408.75, against the real-estate and mining claims of said defen-dant situated in the New Placers mining district in Santa Fe county, N. M., about one and one-half miles northwest of the torus of dickhas in said county on the town of Golden, in said county, on the wagon road leading from said town to the Plaza of Placitas, and being two placer mining claims, containing 160 acres each together with the houses, boilers, pumps dams, wells, well-boring apparatus, pipes casing and other machinery thereon And to subject such mining claims, build-ings and machinery thereon to the payment of their said several claims, together with the costs of preparing, filing and recording their several mechanics' liens, closing the same.
