EMPIRE SILVER BELT:—Way off Amigos! Agreeable to promise, here goes for a short account of my trip to Alaska.

On July 12th our mutual friend Con Casgrove, of Kansas, and myself, bid good-bye to beautiful Santa Barbara, bound for the so-called Wonderland of the far North—sorry to leave for the time being the pleasant bathing, fishing, etc., of the land of flowers and sunshine...
