MINEING LAW.

Laws of Congress Governing the Location, Holding and Working of Mining Claims Upon the Public Domain.

Below will be found an abstract of the Mining Laws of the United States, as passed by Congress, and approved May 10, 1874. These are the laws and regulations which govern the location, holding and working of the various classes of mining claims upon the public domain.
