

DECEASED PRESS.

London, December 12.—The Standard, in its financial article, announces that a fresh competition by telegraphic communication with America and India may be looked for from a new company to be launched next month.

A pigeon-shooting match came off to-day between Dr. Carver and Mr. Gordon at 100 pigeons each for \$100 a side. Carver started 24 yards and Gordon 25 yards, but latter using one hand, Gordon killed 67 birds and Carver 61.

Pittsburg Fire Continued.

PITTSBURG, December 10.—The scene at the ruins this afternoon was desolate. A shanty stood at the opening of the green hollow and nothing remained but three blacked joints and a pair of iron shoes. The site of the building was strewn with kitchen and dining-room furniture more than half consumed and kitchen utensils, sheets of clothing, human bones, strips of crisped flesh and skulls, the latter being found in different places.

On a portion of a parlor a consumed straw-bed was the remains of seven victims piled up in such confusion as to give the beholder an idea of horrible agony. The victims must have suffered before losing consciousness. This bed was located under one of the openings and it was evident from position that the original occupants having escaped, others had sought to flee from the opening but had become hopelessly entangled and suffocated. They were unable to move, and the flames, when the floor of loft gave way charred remains, dropped to the ground below.

Solemn Requiem Mass Offered.

VIENNA, December 12.—An immense concourse of people was present this morning at St. Stephen's Cathedral, where a solemn requiem mass was celebrated for the repose of the souls of the victims of the fire. The Cathedral was entirely draped in black, and the outlandish crowd which was surrounded with candles and exotic plants. The clergy entered the Cathedral in procession followed by the crown prince, Archbishops, members of the Imperial Household, Court dignitaries, members of the Reichsrath, representatives of the Army, Civil Service, Municipality, etc.

Bishop Angerer officiated and the Court Opera Choir assisted, and their voices were occasionally almost drowned by the noise of the mourners. The large square in front of the cathedral and adjoining streets were filled by many thousands of people.

The Government to Stand Firm.

LONDON, December 12.—The Daily News, in a leading article, declares that there is not the slightest chance of the Government yielding to a panic in regard to the currency. Whatever steps may seem necessary for the maintenance of law will be taken on their own authority as the large powers they already possess. The United Ireland, the organ of the Land League will in future be published by the Executive of the League. One lady is already employed in the office of the Dublin French journal.

The Imprisoned Subjects at Milwaukee.

It is believed that the directors of the Pacific Bank new officers must be chosen to conduct the bank's business under the expected reorganization, but the directors stated to-night that nothing had been done in the matter. Colonel Needham absolutely refuses to accept anything less than \$200,000 from Mr. Weeks. The bank has raised \$400,000, and is confident of obtaining the remainder in a few days. A director and an attorney for the bank left for Washington to confer with the comptroller, but the exact nature of their business could not be learned.

Oil Works Burned.

NEW YORK, December 10.—The South Brooklyn oil works, situated at the foot of Huntington street and Gowanus canal, and owned by Deane, Strymer & Co., was totally destroyed by fire this afternoon. The fire started in the lubricating room, spreading to the oil tanks and the oil overflowing, ran down to the canal, and still burning, made it look like a canal of liquid fire. Some of the docks also took fire, but the flames were extinguished before much damage was done. The total loss is estimated at \$25,000, and fully covered by insurance.

Railroad Wreck.

CHATTANOOGA, TENN., December 11.—A frightful accident occurred on the Cincinnati Southern Railroad, twenty miles south of Knoxville and 100 miles north of here, at 10 o'clock this morning. The second section of freight train No. 19 ran into the first section, killing Engineer, Conductor, and brakeman, and leaving several cars wrecked. The cause of the accident is not known. The wreck is being quickly cleared, and there will be but little delay in the passage of trains.

Dead from Apoplexy.

NEW YORK, December 11.—A Troy, New York, special agent Colonel H. Shaffner, of Louisville, Kentucky, suffered a stroke of apoplexy at the Troy House, Saturday, from the effects of which he died last night. He was previously identified with telegraph and railroad enterprises, and instructed the telegraph system in Russia. He represented the State of Kentucky in the National Lodge of Old Fellows. He leaves an estate valued at \$1,000,000.

General James Resignation.

NEW YORK, December 12.—Postmaster-General James, who is in this city this evening, wrote and forwarded to President Arthur his official letter of resignation as Cabinet officer, to take effect January 1st.

THE LONDON STANDARD ON BLAINE.

LONDON, December 12.—The Standard in a leading article on Mr. Blaine's instructions to the American Minister at Lima, says: It may be absurd, but it is only carrying out the Monroe doctrine to its legitimate conclusion to assume that by-and-by we shall see the representatives of the Emperor of Brazil with the European powers, and the savages of Patagonia, invoking the aid of the United States to compose their differences.

What is the temper of the Cabinet at the present moment we can only infer. It is not, perhaps, a matter of sentiment. It is true that Blaine has resigned, and the Americans will no longer have to admire the glories of the past, which he has maintained the pretensions of this country. But American diplomacy is uniform.

It will be much the same whether the dispatches are sent by Frelinghuysen or Blaine. It is not improbable that President Arthur may soon announce that peace is restored and a new protectoral commission will be named by the United States.

The Paris correspondent of the Morning Post announces that the Chambers of Commerce of Paris, Lyons, St. Etienne, Roubaix, Lille, Valenciennes, Combray, Rochelle, Montpelier, Grenoble, Angoulême, Bayonne, Nance, Havre and Marseilles have pronounced in favor of negotiations with the Franco-American treaty of commerce.
