A high British court has followed the opinion expressed by Dr. E. W. Lovett and Dr. E. Reynolds in papers read by them yesterday afternoon before the members of the American Orthopedic Association.

The statement was made in connection with a preliminary study of the mechanics of the upright position with reference to backache, and a consideration of the effect of corsets and high-heeled shoes upon the balance of the human body and upon the position of the center of gravity.

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Official of the government bureau of plant industry has invented a method of testing the moisture content of grain by making use of the principle that the greater the moisture content the greater the electrical conductivity.

Knowledge of the fact that earthquakes always are preceded by electrical waves has enabled an Italian scientist to invent a device which foretells their occurrence several seconds before they are recorded by a sismograph.
