CUMMINGS TO CARRY BATTLE TO 168 TOWNS

Candidate For Senator Plans Whirlwind Tour of the Entire State.

Starting next Monday, Homer S. Cummings of Stamford, Democratic nominee for U. S. Senator from Connecticut, will launch a whirlwind campaign unexampled in the history of the state.

Mr. Cummings' schedule calls for about seven speeches a day, besides all the other work which devolves upon him. In order to make possible this plan of campaign, extraordinary arrangements are necessary.

"It makes no difference whether there is a crowd on hand or not," declared Mr. Cummings, in discussing his plans, "I shall be ready to speak wherever anybody is ready to listen."

"As it is physically impossible for all the people in Connecticut to come out and meet me, I must go out and meet them. I think that every town is entitled to hear from a candidate who stands for the whole state, and I don't propose to skip a single town unless Providence upsets my plans with some accident I cannot foresee."

While it is difficult to announce minutely the itinerary of such a trip, the arrangements at present call for the following schedule during the first three days of the week: Monday, October 9.—Tolland county, beginning at Rockville and ending at Stafford Springs.

ALLEGED SLAVES FUGITIVES FROM REFORM SCHOOL

Couple Escaped From New York State Institution, Police Learn.

Investigation by Lieut. E. O. Cronan, of the record of the two girls who lodged white slave charges against Louis Chistos and George Karagounes, who were arrested in the company of the girls as they alighted from a New York train in this city, revealed the fact that the young women are fugitives from justice.

Word was received by Lieut. Cronan from the New York Federal authorities that they did not care to prosecute the two men. Their cases were continued this morning, at their own request, in bonds of \$1,000, although it is believed the police will be forced to release them owing to the fact that the New York authorities do not care to prosecute them.
