CITY NEWS IN BRIEF.

Leat. Fruit trees are budding. An early spring is predicted. The local society lodges seem to be prospering. Capt. H. M. Pierce has returned from Skagway. The morning boat will leave for Seattle Sunday. J. E. Slight, of Shelton, was in the city Wednesday. Allen White visited his mill at Elma this week. Dr. Strickland returned this morning from Chicago. S. G. Simpson returned from San Francisco Monday. Dan Davis was committed to the insane asylum yesterday. The cupola on the town hall is receiving a new covering of tin. Rev. T. B. Ford, a former pastor of the M. E. Church, is in the city. John Dowling, of Little Rock, returned this week from Skagway. Mrs. Dr. Mitchell returned last evening from a visit down the Sound. The next steamer leaving San Francisco will be the Umatilla, Monday. The annual meeting of Women's Club will take place on the 10th prox. Dr. J. H. McDonald has returned from a trip to the eastern part of the State. Chas. M. Littlejohn and Mabel D. Sparks were united in marriage last evening. It seems that the State printing office is up-to-date in being run by injunction. The weather forecast for tonight and to-morrow is "Fair, with occasional showers."

Prof. A. S. Kerfoot and family, of Bucoda, spent Sunday with relatives in this city. E. J. Cooper shipped 15 head of horses to Seattle by the Multnomah this morning. Mrs. James Longmire, of Yelm, left Monday for an extended visit east of the mountains. Jas. Israel is engaged in cruising timber for the Williamson Logging Co., near Gate City. A season of evangelistic services began Monday night at the United Presbyterian church. A carload of doors and windows was shipped to Portland, Wednesday, by the Olympia Door and Lumber Co. I. Colvin, of Bucoda, died this week in San Francisco, where he had gone for treatment of a cancer of the face. It is the consensus of opinion that business is steadily moving towards its old haunts along lower Main street. The scow being fitted up at Long wharf, with housed "upperworks," is intended for use as a lighter at Dyea. The next steamer for Alaska will be the Australia to-morrow. She is the largest steamer that ever docked at Seattle. Playing marbles on the sidewalks by electric light is a pastime which could have been invented only by Olympia small boys. A. E. Laberec and wife have taken a suite of rooms at the Carlton Hotel where they propose to make their future residence. Jesse Murphy, who returned from Skagway, last week, came very near being a passenger on the ill-fated Clara Nevada. The Multnomah was two hours late last evening on account of the shipment of 800 Alaskan sleds from Tacoma to Seattle. Al. J. Munson, Postmaster at Shelton, accompanied by his wife, came up Monday to witness the performance of "Under the Dome."

A large shipment (300 sacks) of flour came by the Multnomah last evening, for the Merchant's Mercantile Co., at Matlock. The City Council Monday night met "Under the Dome" instead of in the Council Chamber, and that accounts for a meagre report of their doings. Mrs. L. M. Hall left Tuesday for her former home in Michigan, on a visit to her mother, who is suffering from a limb broken in a sleighing accident. R. G. Thompson, who went East a couple of months ago to undergo surgical treatment for relief from bodily injuries, died at Ann Arbor, Mich., on the 14th inst. The trial of the libel suit of State Printer Hicks vs. Espey et al., a typographical union in Seattle, has by motion of defendants been transferred to the King county courts. Mr. John Corkish, President of the Olympia Pipe Factory, who has been in the city this week, looking after the interests of the company, returned to his home in Portland, yesterday. The State printing embroglio reminds one of a game of stud-poker in which there are many players and each endeavor by stolidity of countenance

to prevent others from guessing his hand. Mrs. Gottfeldt has received a letter from the nation of the hospital for the insane, at Shelton, stating that Mrs. Dwyer, better known as the "Queen," will shortly be released from that institution. C. C. Angle, father of Grant C. Angle of the Shelton Journal, and at one time a resident of Olympia, died suddenly of heart failure at Sylvan, a suburb of Portland, on the 15th inst. He was 65 years of age. The steamer Junitta, towed a scow from Shelton to Kamille yesterday, laden with a locomotive for the Blakely Railroad. In consequence of this extra service she failed to make her regular trip to this city. J. C. Allen, a veteran of the war, died at his Westside residence, Wednesday morning, after a protracted illness. He was 90 years of age and leaves a wife and family. He was buried yesterday under the auspices of the G. A. R. Mrs. A. G. Sawin sustained a severe injury by dislocation of the left wrist, Saturday evening, from a fall. It was found that she had sustained other injuries, but the rest so far has not sustained that apprehension, and it is hoped her recovery will be speedy. Last Saturday the class in physics from the high school, accompanied by Superintendent Hawes, "took in" the power-house at Tumwater. Thereby seeing in practical application the electrical instruments concerning which they have recently seen studying. The pleasant weather of the past week, taken as a whole, reminds us of the approach of the season when spades become the leading suit and "de shubble and de hooch," which became incumbent on Uncle Joe's death suddenly assume their wanted animation. Chas. Ford, a brother of our well-known townsman, T. N. Ford, is a sojourner for a few days in this place. Probably in one respect, at least, the Olympia high school has not an equal in the State. There are thirty-three boys in school and not one of them uses tobacco in any form. Superintendent Hawes is very proud of this fact and prouder still of the boys that create the fact. The Ladies' Relief Society, Tuesday night, kindly postponed the hour of opening their soiree to afford an opportunity for theater-goers to attend the play as well as the ball. The concession was appreciated, for their selection of date was made before the dramatic contract was signed. The Olympia high school were the recipients of two gifts during the week which the pupils greatly appreciate. Mr. A. S. Hall sent up several yards of national bunting to be used for decorative purposes and Mr. C. H. Springer gave a framed picture of the Washington State building at the Columbian Exposition. Dr. Newell, during his late visit to this city, registered as a voter, which indicates that he still considers Olympia his home. He has always maintained a warm place in his affection for the capital city and his many friends of the county, resulting from his long residence, and they will be pleased at this intimation that he still is, and will continue to be, a permanent resident. H. H. Symonds, an employe of Mosher & McDonald's camp, returned Saturday night from Seattle, and after leaving the boat took the wrong direction to come up town and walked off the north end of Percival's dock. After clinging to a pile for about fifteen minutes his shouts for help brought rescuers, who by the aid of a rope pulled him out of the channel. He was sober when he reached the city. A special meeting of the Thurston County Horticultural Society is called for next Saturday, at its room in the court house in this city, at 2 o'clock p. m., to receive a report from the joint committee of the Horticultural Society and of the Chamber of Commerce. All who have an interest in the welfare of the city and the country tributary thereto, are cordially invited to attend and listen to the report. Miss Avery's primary department of the public school, at Tumwater, gave an entertainment Monday afternoon, in commemoration of the season's holiday, and each of the pupils received as a souvenir a diminutive hatched decorated with clusters of cherries. To-night the remainder of the pupils will entertain their parents and friends in Keifer's hall, the nature of the exercises partaking, of course, of the Washingtonian spirit. Jack Cronin was yesterday brought into the Superior Court before Judge Hodgdon, temporarily presiding, and arraigned on the information charging him with murder. His attorney, Mr. Israel, filed a motion to strike the information, on the grounds that the preliminary examination had not been legally held and because the information was not properly verified by the Prosecuting Attorney. This last question is a new one and has never been passed upon by our Supreme Court. The motion was overruled and Cronin's attorney reserved an exception. This morning a demurrer to the information was presented and overruled, and Cronin was granted three days to plead. It is understood Judge Hodgdon will return on Tuesday next.

Among the *habeas corpus* methods of education, in which our local schools keep steady pace, is the institution of a congress, by the Washington school, with all the officers and all the dignity and state of our national legislature, excepting only the drawing of princely salaries and a division of various other emoluments. The upper house, or Senate, very properly, is composed entirely of girls, with a young lady for President, and the House is made up entirely of boys, with a rising statesman for Speaker. The former held their sessions in the attic of the school building and the latter in the cellar, which is undesignated an indication of the characteristics of the sexes and the effects claimed by the advocates of woman's enfranchisement. The Senate in this instance, represents the purity, the fidelity and conscientiousness of the body politic, the upper stratum of moral incentive, while the House is emblematic of the dignity, strength and endurance, the foundation stone of the structure. A combination of these elements constitute a perfect and majestic whole, the highest conception of government of and by a free people.

Donald Stewart, of Aberdeen, while handling his rifle the other day, was wounded in the foot by the accidental discharge. The bullet passed clear through his foot. A death watch has been placed over John Leonard, the ex-convict, who was Monday, at Colfax, sentenced to be hanged March 25th for the murder of Jacob Malquist. The Gray's Harbor Commercial Company, of Cosmopolis, contemplate adding another planer and making other improvements. A night crew will shortly be put on. Captain C. Westney died Tuesday morning, at Chelalis, of heart failure. He was one of the founders of the

Populist party at that place, and one of the best known men in Lewis county. At one time he was editor of the *People's Advocate*. John C. Ellison, Assessor of Kittitas county, died Monday, of cancer. This is the second death in the ranks of the Populist office-holders, the Sheriff having died last September. The West & Slade Mill Company, of Aberdeen, are putting in new machinery to increase the capacity of their mill. As soon as completed the mill is run night and day. John J. Jones, a native of England, aged 27 years, was killed at Jas. Simpson's camp at Lake Nahahual, back of Shelton, recently, by a tree falling on him. He was head skidder on the camp. John Malander, log hauler at the Bellingham Bay improvement Company's mill, at Whatcom, fell ten feet from the log slip, Tuesday morning, and had all the ribs of one side crushed in. He died shortly afterward. He was a married man, about 30 years old. The daily receipts of milk at the North Yakima creamery now averages about 7,000 pounds, from which are produced about 300 pounds of butter. For this milk the farmers are getting 88 cents a 100, so that the creamery is distributing about \$1,900 a month. Burglars broke into the house of Mrs. Rose Oberly, in Whatcom, last Friday night, and stole a gold watch and other valuables. The work was done very hurriedly. The thief got in through a window. The family were down below in the kitchen at the time. Monday afternoon John Leonard, convicted of the murder of Jacob Malquist July 18, 1896, was for the third time sentenced to be hanged. The date of execution was fixed for March 25. Leonard had intended to make a statement, but was too nervous to speak. Mrs. George W. Ellis, proprietress of the Lutz house in Seattle, shot today a masked burglar who was tempted to enter her sleeping apartments Monday morning, about 4 o'clock. At the first shot the burglar fell out of the window with a groan, but recovering, ran away. Mrs. Ellis shot at him again and he commenced to limp. She is positive he got in through the body once and thinks he was also hit in the leg.

Never in the history of Kittitas county has the ground been in so good a condition for crops as it is now. Heavy rains last fall gave ample moisture. Then the fall of snow was such that at least 18 inches was in sight when the February break-up came. An immense quantity of water has gone into the ground, and the result means much for the coming season's crops. Captain Peter Matthews, proprietor of the Hoquiam shipyard, last week closed contracts at San Francisco to construct at Hoquiam three large, four-masted vessels. They are to be
