DRAFT BILL TO AID CLEARING OF LAND

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE OUTLINES PLANS FOR AIDING SETTLERS ON LOGGED LANDS.

The committee appointed by the recent logged-off land conference at the University of Washington held its first meeting at the Commercial club in Tacoma this week, with Dr. H. K. Benson of the state university presiding.

After a discussion and hearing from several interested, the committee agreed upon a definite program by which a bill is to be prepared and submitted to the legislature.

Outlines Proposed Bill. In commenting on the proposed bill one of the committee said: "This district will be authorized to provide actual settlers with stumping powder sufficient to clear 20 acres as a maximum, clearing to be done under expert supervision, at a cost not to exceed \$500."

"The second step is for the state to enter upon a deliberate program of reforesting its land not available for agriculture. Professor B. P. Kirkland, forester at the university, showed at the conference that the present volume of timber owned by the state could be retained for all time and made to pay cost of its own reforestation."

"A third problem is the fact that much logged-off land is held at speculative prices too high to be available for settlement. The question of solving this by taxation or by other means was considered at length. An appeal will be made for the co-operation of owners of large tracts to get them in the hands of actual settlers in small tracts at reasonable prices and terms."

"The state of Washington owns more than 100,000 acres of logged-off lands in 28 counties, ranging from 80 acres in Ferry county to 3,500 in Pierce, 3,900 in Whatcom, 4,000 in Skagit, 4,400 in Lewis, 5,200 in King, 5,900 in Thurston, 6,200 in Snohomish, 8,000 in Spokane, 10,000 in Mason and 13,000 in Stevens."

HUGE FEDERAL FUND FOR ROAD BUILDING

\$85,000,000 APPROPRIATED BY GOVERNMENT FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION IN STATES.

The sum of \$85,000,000 of federal funds is made available for the construction of rural roads, by the passage of the federal aid road bill which became a law July 11. Of this sum, \$75,000,000 is to be expended for the construction of rural post roads under cooperative arrangements with the highway departments of the various states, and \$10,000,000 is to be expended for roads and trails within or partly within the national forests.

The act limits the federal government's share in road work in cooperation with the states to 50 per cent of the estimated cost of construction Federal aid may be extended to the construction of any rural post road, excluding all streets or roads in towns having a population of 2,500 or more, except the portions of such streets or roads on which the houses are, on an average, more than 200 feet apart.

Five million dollars is made available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1917, and thereafter the appropriation is increased at the rate of five millions a year until 1921, when the sum provide is \$25,000,000, making a total of \$75,000,000. In addition an appropriation of \$1,000,000 a year for 10 years—a total of \$10,000,000—is made available for the development of roads and trails wholly or partly within the national forests.
