CANADA RANKS NEXT TO UNITED STATES

In Number of Automobiles Per Capita Manufactured and Owned.

Canada is now the second nation in the world in the manufacture of automobiles, number of cars owned and the percapita distribution, the United States takes first rank.

Figures compiled by the Motor Bus and Motorize the Farm Bureau of The Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company shows that one person in every fifteen in the United States owns an automobile, while one in every twenty-three is the percentage in Canada.

The total number cars registered in this country is approximately 7,100,000, in the Dominion 350,000 and in England 180,000.

Rural Canada owns more than half the cars operated in the Dominion, and in the prairie provinces the percentage is greater. It is estimated that the total Canadian production of automobiles in 1920 will be increased 35 per cent over 1919.
