

CASPIAN DIRECTORY

List of Summer Residents, Their Camps, Business, Colleges, Degrees, Children and Guests, Given in Condensed Form for Reference

This summer a resident of the camp at the lake conceived the idea of publishing a directory of the campers about Lake Caspian. He was called away before he could complete the work and The Caledonian consented to take his data and publish a list of the cottagers, with the name of their camp, the village in which it is located, the owner of the cottage, the business or profession of the members, the college from which they graduated, the degree, members of the family and guests. We are indebted to David and William P. Kelly, Jr., for the collection of the data, a task that was faithfully performed. The matter collected if arranged in tabular form would occupy more space than this whole section of the paper and we are obliged to print it in more condensed form.

Classifying the heads of families located here we find there are 42 connected with some form of business, 25 connected with educational work, 15 with the ministry, seven with the law and four doctors. This gives returns for 93 families. This evidently does not include all as there are over 100 cottages about the lake. Some refused to give data and doubtless some failed to get the blanks filled in time for publication.

The matter is arranged as follows: First in capital letters is the family name. In the next paragraph is given the name of the cottage and the village in which it is located (whenever both are given.) Next is given the owner. If it is the occupant the word "Occupant" is printed to save repetition of the name; if owned by someone else the name and address of the owner is given. Then is given the months the family spend in camp and the number of seasons they have been here.

In the next paragraph the initials or Christian name (whichever was given on the blanks) is given, his business or profession, his address, the institutions from which he has graduated and the degrees he has been given. Following this are the members of his family and other occupants, and in a separate paragraph the guests at the cottage.

This key to the style, we trust, will enable all to intelligently read the list of residents and the honors which they have won.




