## GAS EXPLOSION KILLS 11 MINERS

BODIES RECOVERED FROM PENNSYLVANIA MINE AFTER HOURS OF WORK.

### SIX RESCUERS ARE INJURED

Foreman's Son Sole Survivor of Party in Ill-Fated Heading—Rescuers Battle Bravely to Rescue Victims.

Indiana, Pa.—An explosion of a pocket of gas caused a disaster at the Rochester and Pittsburg Coal company's mine at Ernest, near this city, Saturday that resulted in the death of eleven miners, all foreigners and married except one. Mike Harrington, son of Foreman Harrington, is the only man in the heading who escaped, and he is badly hurt. Five members of a track crew heard the explosion and went to the aid of their comrades, but were burned and partially overcome. Their fate did not deter Foreman Harrington from organizing another party and starting to effect a rescue. Harrington fainted from after-damp and had to be carried out. He will recover.

Bodies Are Recovered. Until late in the afternoon rescuers fought their way along hastily constructed brattices in an effort to reach the men, and at 4:30 o'clock their car returned with the bodies. The dead were carried to a carpenter shop, where identification was made. Previous to that time only about eighty watchers had remained at the mine mouth, but news of the bringing out of the bodies brought hundreds to the scene.

There were few incidents usually attending such accidents, only three women keeping vigil at the mine. Man Thought Safe Is Dead. A sad sight was that of a heart-broken lad of 12 looking for his father in the death house. Mrs. Vincent Tamfr thought her husband was visiting in Iselin and was telling her neighbors of his fortunate escape when his lifeless form was brought to the house. He had returned this morning and gone direct to work. It was eight hours after the gas explosion before company officials arrived from Puncusutawney, 30 miles distant. Then came Superintendent A. W. Calloway, General Manager John Reed, mining engineers, inspectors, nurses and doctors, but their services were not required.

### FIREMEN "CHASE A FIRE"

Fire Set to Peddler's Rags by Mischievous Boys Scorches Horse and He Bolts. New York City.—The members of Engine Company No. 33 never knew what "chasing a fire" really meant until Friday night when they answered a call from Broadway and 138th street. When the engine arrived on the spot the fire was at 145th street and was still going north. "It's three blocks up," shouted a driver when they reached 141st street. It was overtaken at 147th street and extinguished. The blaze was in a load of rags and paper on a peddler's wagon. Mischievous boys had touched a match to the load while the peddler was in a house. The horse, alarmed by the flames scorching his tail, had started driverless up Broadway.

### HIGH PRICE FOR PAINTINGS

Pictures Sold at Auction Bring \$255,750 in an Hourly Millet Sells for \$53,100. New York City.—In just one hour last night in Mendelssohn Hall, Thomas E. Kirby, of the American Art Association, sold twenty-one paintings, comprising the last collection formed by H. S. Henry of Philadelphia, for a total of \$255,750. One of the pictures, Millet's "Going to Work—Dawn of Day," was bought by Scott and Fowles for \$53,100, this canvas having been bought by Henry last April in the Martin sale in the same hall for \$50,000. It was the last picture he bought before his death.
