## SEVEN YEARS OF CRIME NETS \$500

Daring Burglar Decides to Reform After He Leaves Prison.

Long Island City, N. Y.—After having spent seven years as a burglar and all-around robber and gaining less than \$500 in all of that time, eighteen-year-old Stephen Leyser told Supreme Justice Humphrey in Long Island City, N. Y., that he had decided to take up another career as soon as he had the opportunity. He pleaded guilty of having stolen an overcoat from a tailor shop and was sentenced to the state reformatory.

"I am going to keep a watch on your record there," said the judge, "and if

you behave yourself I will help you start on a new career when you get out."

"I'll be as good as any boy in the institution," he replied.

Leyser was known to the police as "Yellow Spot." Every time he would commit a burglary he would leave behind a card bearing that name. He often left notes denouncing the police for not being able to catch criminals. In one of these left in the tailor shop he said they would be able to catch thieves if they were not so much interested in moving picture shows while on duty.

The police had sought "Yellow Spot" for months, but they were astounded when Leyser admitted he was the criminal. Despite his youth he has spent several years in prisons and institutions.

## COURT LIKES MALE ATTIRE

Finds it Not Unbecoming in Mary Schmidt and Refuses to Fine Her for Wearing It.

St. Louis.—Ruling that male attire was not unbecoming to Mrs. Mary Bertha Schmidt, alias "Mr. Schmidt," Judge Hogan, in police court here, refused to fine the young woman who for two years posed as a man and who "married" her cousin, Anna Assade last October.

"I think you look very nice," said the court. Mrs. Schmidt was clad in her neatly pressed trousers and pin-back coat. She explained she had adopted the garments because she could earn \$80 a month as a man and \$6 a week as a woman.

"If a woman can earn \$3 a day by reason of wearing trousers, I say wear 'em," said the court, and "Mr. Schmidt" walked out of court with a smile on "his" face.

## DRAFT TOOK HER TROUSERS

Woman Who Had Masqueraded as Man Fled to Desert to Keep Her Secret.

San Bernardino, Cal.—"John Bauer," must return to skirts after having lived eight years as a man. The selective draft law barred her secret to the world.

"Bauer," twenty-four years old, was apprehended in Death valley, near San Bernardino, where she had been living a year in solitude in an effort to avoid military registration.

According to the story told by the girl, she had been working as a man in and around San Bernardino seven years, and no one suspected her real sex. Then came the draft registration law, and she fled to the desert to protect her secret.
