BE IT REMEMBERED THAT AT A Regular Term of the County Court of Iron County begun and held at the Court House in the City of Ironton, on MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2nd, 1919, the following among other proceedings were had:—

IN THE MATTER OF THE BOND ISSUE FOR BUILDING AND IMPROVING ROADS— Election Ordered

Now at this day comes J. L. Baldwin, Mann Ringo and W. D. Kendall and present to the Court a petition and application in writing signed by more than 200 tax-paying citizens and legally qualified voters of Iron County, Missouri, requesting that a proposition be submitted to the qualified voters of said County to issue bonds in the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) for the purpose of grading, constructing, paving, and maintaining of paved, macadamized and rock roads and necessary bridges and culverts therein and thereon.

Said petition and the names of the petitioners being as follows, to-wit:—

"TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT, IRON COUNTY, MISSOURI,

We, the undersigned, being more than 200 resident tax-paying citizens of Iron County, Missouri, respectfully request that the proposition be submitted to the qualified voters of Iron County, Missouri, to issue the bonds of said Iron County, Missouri, in the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), the proceeds of said bonds to be used for the grading, construction and maintaining of graded and rock roads and necessary bridges and culverts therein and thereon.

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said petition is signed by more than 200 legal tax-paying citizens and qualified voters of Iron County, Missouri, and that said petition sets forth the object and purpose for which said election is to be held, and that it is necessary for the County of Iron to incur an indebtedness in excess of the total income and revenues of the said County provided for any one year as limited by law, for the purpose of building, paving and maintaining paved, graveled, macadamized and rock roads and necessary bridges and culverts therein and thereon and that said indebtedness sought to be incurred therefor does not, including the existing indebtedness of said County, exceed in the aggregate 10 per centum of the value of the taxable property of said County as ascertained by the assessment next before the last assessment for State and County purposes.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that a special election be held at each and all the Election Precincts in Iron County, Missouri, on

Saturday, the 13th Day of December, 1919,

The same being within 45 days of the making of this order. Said Election to be held in the same manner as general elections are held; submitting to the qualified voters of Iron County, Missouri, for their assent, approval and adoption the proposition of issuing bonds of Iron County, Missouri, in the sum of \$200,000, the proceeds of the bonds to be used for the grading, construction, paving and maintenance of paved, graveled, macadamized and rock roads and necessary bridges and culverts in said County.

It is further ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court shall give notice of said special election by causing this order to be published once a week in four separate issues of the Iron County Register and the Arcadia Valley Enterprise, two weekly newspapers printed and published in Iron County, Missouri, the last insertion to be made prior to the date of said special election."
