BEARS A CHARMED LIFE.
 An Ohio Farmer Who Lives in Splendour Numerous Accidents.

 If ever a man bore a charmed life, Nathan Porter of Cross Creek Township is that man. He has met with a number of accidents that would have ended the life of any ordinary human being, but fate seems possessed of a kindly will for him. He is just now going about, after having been kicked squarely in the forehead by a horse. His apple orchard is on the side of a hill, and he has fallen out of nearly every tree in it several times, and never was more than shaken up.

Some years ago a log rolled over him as if he had been made of rubber. Then he went to a picnic and ate ice cream that poisoned everybody else, but beyond a little sick spell, he never felt any discomfort. New French Reodorizer.
 Mention is made in the scientific press of a deodorizing attachment to be used in the car of oil and gas engine exhausts. Its principal action depends upon the absorbing properties of bone black, or the affinity which the latter has for certain other substances, among these being the objectionable compounds of the combustion gases from oil engines. The bone black in this case is made to exercise a double effect—acting by absorption as well as in a mechanical way by filtration. The device consists of a box divided into two compartments by a perforated partition, on which the bone black is spread in a moderately thick layer. The exhaust gases from the engine enter into the lower compartment at the extreme left, pass through the perforated dividing wall and superimposed layer of absorbent into the upper compartment, and thence escape into the open air through a pipe at the upper right-hand side. Thus the ammonia and feld hydrocarbon gases are absorbed by the bone black, and whatever liquid offensive particles may be in the products of combustion are retained by it mechanically. Water of condensation collecting in the lower compartment may be drained off through a drip pipe.
