Washington Boys Prominent in the Various College Teams

Conspicuous Positions Held by Them at Yale, Harvard, Princeton, and at Other Universities—Curtis' Outstanding Work at High Jumping, Dudley a Star on the Blue Team

Every season sets the names of numbers of Washington boys on the roles of the football elevens of the large Northern colleges, but this year the number has increased to a point never equaled before. In the athletic circles of Princeton, Cornell, and Yale universities, Washington men are this year holding conspicuous positions.

At Princeton George Curtis, who graduated from the city's High School in '08, is just beginning his sophomore year. He has made an enviable athletic record in the past season, having won five second prizes for high jumping in the college games. Mr. Curtis' record for the high jump is five feet ten inches, which he made last year in the Cornell-Princeton game.

At Cornell, Washington has three representatives—Yankee, Young and Dudley. Young and Tausig entered Cornell last year, and have already established themselves as line athletes. Young has confined himself to sprinting, and he has done very good work in the inter-collegiate games. He has, however, injured his right leg and will be compelled to keep away from the club path until after Christmas. Tausig has made a good record in good football work. He is not on the regular varsity team, but his record as a substitute has been appreciated by the coach, and there is little doubt but that he will be put on the varsity next year.

Dudley is an old Columbia Athletic Club member. He participated three years ago as a member of the varsity football team in his freshman year. The same year he secured the touchdown against the Princeton tigers. This year Dudley has not been playing any football, as he is pretty well used up. It is possible, however, that he will play before the season ends.

Lincoln is a graduate of the Friends Select School. Last year he entered Yale and soon joined the freshman crew in the eight-oared shell. His excellent work during the past season entitles him to a good chance of entering the varsity crew this year.

In Swarthmore College Washington captain of the football team. Harry Beard is well known in the city, having three years played end tackle on the Columbia University team.

On the Swarthmore eleven he is playing left back, and this year every man that has played football here has had good cause to remember his prowess, as his end running has been phenomenal and the subject of much talk in the smaller colleges.
