APPAIRS OF THE DISTRICT

Annual Report of the Property Clerk Submitted.

Makes a Good Showing of Business Done During Last Year—Recommends That the Salaries of the Deputy and Clerks Be Slightly Increased—Other Interesting Matters.

F. O. Beckett, the District Property Clerk, today submitted his report to the Commissioners for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1900, together with certain recommendations deemed advisable for the more effective transaction of business in his office.

"This is the purchasing office," he says, "of all supplies for all departments of the District Government, except those which are under the supervision of the Engineer Commissioner. It is also the accounting office for the same departments. It is here that a record is kept of all expenditures, and the condition of the appropriations made by Congress for all the departments, except as above mentioned. During the fiscal year ended June 30, 1900, there was expended through this office appropriations amounting, in round numbers, to \$710,800. There were 3,967 requisitions made upon the office of supplies, which necessitated the writing of 8,591 orders; 7,225 bills were presented for supplies furnished, which were examined, recorded, and forwarded to the proper officers for approval before being sent to the Auditor of the District for settlement.

"Each year there are prepared by this office specifications and blank forms of proposals for furnishing the District with such supplies as it is known will be purchased during the next fiscal year, with an estimate of the quantities that will be required. These blank forms of proposals last year consisted of twenty classes, with an estimated value of \$1,000,000. The proposals were purchased during the current year. Bids for these supplies are opened, as are other bids to furnish the District, and the board appointed by the Commissioners, consisting of the Chief Clerk and Superintendent of Property of the Engineer Department, and the Property Clerk of the District of Columbia, at a time designated by the Secretary of the Treasury, as required by law. After being scheduled by a committee appointed for that purpose, they are then referred to this office for examination and report. They are then sent to the Board, as are the proposals for supplies for all executive departments, under the United States Government, consisting of the Assistant Secretaries of Treasury and Interior, Department of the Interior, and the Postmaster General, respectively, who recommend the acceptance or rejection of all of said proposals.

"Last year I had the honor to recommend that the clause which limited the purchase by the District to 25 per cent above the estimated quantity in the stationery class be stricken out of the contract, and your board saw fit to approve. As that clause still remains in the school-book class, I will at the proper time recommend that it also be stricken out, and the contract to be stricken out of the contract and to the great disadvantage of the District. "The message in salary bills, which has been introduced in a thorough and systematic manner, which enables me to furnish, on short notice, any information which may be desired by the Commissioners or the heads of departments.

"During the month of February, 1900, Mr. Henry Shinn was appointed to a clerical position in this office at a salary of \$720 per annum. He has a hard and trying job, and one that should pay more money than the arduous duties performed. His work is being performed by the audit clerk in the office of the Auditor, who receives a salary of \$1,400 per annum. I therefore recommend that Congress be asked to increase the salary of this position to \$1,000 per annum, being an increase of \$280.

"The executive clerk, who has been promoted by the Auditor, who receives a salary of \$1,400 per annum, I therefore recommend that Congress be asked to increase the salary of this position to \$1,200 per annum, a decrease of \$200. Also that the salary of my deputy, Mr. Hargrove, be increased from \$1,200 to \$1,400 per annum, an increase of \$200. Mr. Hargrove has been in the office for the past thirteen years, and during that time has proved a faithful and efficient clerk, and has through his energetic and self-reliance, and the assistance of his assistants, managed the office of the District of Columbia, Maryland, and New Jersey all won trophies and honors. The entire satisfaction of the country, and the recommendation that the position be changed from messenger to messenger clerk, and that the salary be increased from \$600 to \$700 per annum, an increase of \$100. Should you see fit to grant my requests, which I sincerely trust you will, the salaries of this office will then be as follows:

"Property clerk, \$1,800; deputy property clerk, \$1,400; clerk, \$1,200; clerk, \$1,000, and messenger clerk, \$720.

A letter has been addressed to John B.
