

WEST VIRGINIA CHARTERS.

The Secretary of State kept busy issuing Certificates. CHARLESTON, W. Va., Feb. 15.—The Secretary of State's office is kept quite busy issuing certificates of incorporation, mostly to foreign countries. It is said that the new law, has stirred up the foreign applicants and they are taking advantage of the low prices that now exist.

Certificates have been issued to the Owyhee Gold and Silver Mining Company, of Chicago. The capital is \$1,000, but the company is given the right to increase it to \$1,500,000.
