AFFAIRS OF THE DISTRICT. The Commissioners Refuse to Extend Time on a Contract.

The New Jersey Avenue Sewage Pumping Station Involved—Orders for Public Improvements Issued Through the Engineer Department. The Commissioners recently received a communication from R. D. Wood & Co., of the Camden Iron Works, Philadelphia, in which they asked an extension of time for the completion of their contract to furnish the District centrifugal pump, boilers, engine, etc., for use in the New Jersey Avenue sewage pumping station.

The Commissioners today authorized the execution of the following public work through the Engineer Department to be done according to the provisions of the assessment system: To construct sewers as follows: Along the west side of North Capitol Street and of Traxton Circle, between 4th and 5th streets and Quincy Street, abutting lots 10, 11 and 12, of block 12, Bloomingdale, estimated cost \$400.

The Commissioners have issued an order providing that the time for the completion of contract 269, with M. F. McNamee & Co., for the construction of sewer along Connecticut Avenue extended, between Nourse Road and Pierce's Mill Road, be extended for a period of sixty days, or until November 1st, 1901.

The Commissioners recently received a letter from Thomas W. Smith, in which the name of B. Stanley Simmons was presented as architect for the proposed police station at Tenleytown. The matter was referred to the Inspector of Buildings, and he reported that the name of B. Stanley Simmons was appropriated for the purchase of the site.
