

A FAIRLY STRONG MARKET.

Despite Decline in London Stocks Prices Advance in New York.

Atchison a Feature, with a Good Gain. Attributed to Fine Earnings Report—Grangers and Pacific Generally Firm—Vanderbilts Quiet.

NEW YORK, Oct. 1.—The London market for American stocks was again this morning shown at substantial declines. The losses in many instances extended to 1 per cent. No special explanation of the tendency of prices was reported there beyond the fact that Paris continued to sell the Copper stock.

The local market, however, opened practically unaffected by the decline in London. Amalgamated Copper was the only firm, but Anaconda Mining was dealt in below yesterday's final figures. A notably firm feature the railway list was Atchison, common, in which instance the buying was attributed to the splendid showing made in the company's annual report.

Union Pacific, Southern Railway, Union Pacific and St. Paul were all decidedly firm. The United States Steel issues opened strong, but receded from their leading figures. The Vanderbilt issues were only moderately active and were dealt in around yesterday's closing prices.

Nothing, however, of importance was comprised in this morning's intelligence of a character likely to affect the market one way or the other.

NEWS FROM GEORGETOWN.

Gunners Arrested for Shooting Squirrels in Rock Creek Park.

Nine of the Little Animals Killed. Tenleytown Police Sub-Station Site—Death of Mrs. B. T. Sullivan, A Month's Custom House Receipts.

Rock Creek Park was invaded yesterday by two gunners who shot nine squirrels. Sergeant Harry and Policeman Blake discovered the men as they were leaving the reservation and took them into custody. The law does not permit the shooting of squirrels until November 1, and imposes a fine of \$2 for each one found on the person.

The men arrested gave their names as George W. Mattingly and James Collins, and were furnished the necessary collateral for their release.
