NEW YORK, Nov. 28.—Little of importance transpired over the Thanksgiving holiday with any bearing upon the general market or particular stocks.

SEATTLE, Wash., Nov. 28.—Mellie Hennius, of Cecilia Ignace, as she is known to the priest and parishioners of the Squamish mission, Vancouver, has been awarded the medal of the Royal Humane Society by the mayor of Vancouver.
