HOW IT IS DONE.

The supply of crime-proof tires for the process of taking out the policy is continually increasing. The bicycle presents his wheel to the insuring agent. He places the tire upon it. If the machine is comparatively new, the cost of the tire is its insurance value. That is, the value of the wheel is intended to guide the insurer in the amount of the premium. The value of the tire is placed upon a card with the value, insuring name, address and date, and as the six dollars changes into the insurer's hand the card reaches the office of the nearest repair shop employed by the insurance company, and listed on the books of the shop, and the repair is made free of charge.
