FAVORING HIS SUPPORTERS Diekie Johnson Absent When Two Gamblers Were to Be Prosecuted.

Great Indignation Not Only Among Those Who Opposed His Election, But His Supporters.

The failure of Commonwealth's Attorney Johnson to be on hand to attend to the duties of the office caused two of the most notorious gamblers in the county to escape.

Some weeks ago Sheriff Palmer raided the gambling houses of Nelson and Foster, in Alexandria county, near Boston, and captured a lot of gamblers, including the white rackets men in full blast.

The prisoners were there, a host of witnesses also, but no Commonwealth's attorney. After waiting a reasonable time for him to appear, the justice dismissed the case and the men went free.

The failure on the part of Johnson to show up has caused much unfavorable comment, not only from those who had opposed him, but from his own supporters.

A few more cases like this and Diekie it is said, will be removed by impeachment from office by Judge Cliechester.
