

RANDALL'S LITTLE BOOM.

GETTING IN LINE FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATION.

McMillin, of Tennessee, on the Subsidy Question—Southern Postal Points—Capt. L. Notes.

MEMPHIS, AUGUST 6.

WASHINGTON, August 6.—Representative Randall left for home this afternoon, and his family will follow tomorrow. Mr. Randall has been invited to participate in the next democratic caucus, which is to be held in Chicago on the 14th inst., in favor of Michael Davitt. The affair is in the hands of the united Irish associations of the country, and it is expected that at least 10,000 will be present.

Only half a dozen members were at the House today. The House of Representatives presented a despatch from the President, which was read and the speaker's table was cleared of all bills for the first time in the history of Congress. This was due to the new rules, which provide that each member of the House should be present at the House to be considered in the House, or Committee of the Whole. The number of bills pocketed by the President was fifteen, including the omnibus bill for the relief of the pensioners of the late General Sherman. The House Postmaster had been notified up to noon today of 175 members who had departed and 100 more who would be before tomorrow morning.

Not fifty members will remain over ten days, and the speaker has given notice that he would stay here during summer. Although many will return at intervals to look after appointments, forty Senators had left up to noon today. The rest will go within a week. No member of either House is expected to remain in the city and Senator Riddleberger had received of yesterday's session. All is quiet among the Potomac.

THE SUBSIDY QUESTION.

In the closing hours yesterday, Mr. McMillin, of Tennessee, presented from the Committee on the American Ship Building and Ship Owning Interests an adverse report on Mr. Negley's bill giving a subsidy to American ships. The report concludes with the statement that under our form of government the best interests of the people were most aptly observed by protecting our citizens in their life, liberty and pursuit of happiness, and allowing them to select and pursue their vocation without rich influence, and without increasing the prosperity and wealth of one citizen at the expense of another.

Extirpation of Picnic Facemasks.

WASHINGTON, August 6.—Commissioner of Internal Revenue, a circular containing rules and regulations for cooperation between United States Department of Agriculture and the authorities of the several States and Territories for the suppression and extirpation of picnicking, was approved by the President on August 6th, and will be in force from August 1st, 1886, and the last of the year. The Commissioner will employ in such manner as he may deem proper, not more than 100 men to prevent the spread of picnicking.
