From inside sources the London correspondent of THE DISPATCH has ascertained the history of the death of Crown Prince Rudolf, of Austria, which he cables, and which is interesting. The Crown Prince, it seems, shot himself and his sweet-heart took a fatal dose of strychnine. Because they could not be united in life they concluded to die together.

GETTING INTO LINE.

The Interstate Commission Reports That the Southern Railroads Are Trying to Comply With the Law—If Necessary the Law Will be Modified.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—In the Interstate Commerce Commission an opinion was today filed by Commissioner Walker, containing the results reached in respect to the investigation of the tariffs and classifications of the railroads operating in the Southern States, which was held by the Commission in December last. The methods employed by the Southern Railway and Steamship Association in making rates from the Eastern cities and cities in the Northwest to association points in Southern States, and the opinion then takes up the tariff of several of the leading lines of operating in the Southern States and reviews their methods of preparing tariffs and of classifying freight with considerable details. The principal points discussed are the measure of compliance which has been yielded to the fourth section of the act to regulate commerce and the forms in which the tariffs have been made up for publication and filing, as required by the act.

NO USE FOR TELEPHONES.

Electric Street Car Lines Can Run Them Out at Pleasure.

AKRON, March 30.—The first case in the court involving the conflict between the electric street railway and telephone companies to their respective rights to earth and air on the city thoroughfares, was decided here today. Judge E. P. Green refused to grant the Central Union Telephone Company an injunction restraining the Akron Electric Street Railway Company from extending its line in the city. The telephone company claimed that the induction from the electric railway wires makes it impossible for many of its subscribers to use their instruments. The case was contested warmly on both sides. Congressman John A. Wise, of Virginia, appearing for the electric railway and A. Thomas, of Chicago, for the telephone company. The latter gives notice of appeal.

At Lancaster notice has been posted in the rolling mill of the Columbia Iron Company that the mill will shut down on April 5, owing to the dullness of the market.


