

BIG DAY FOR TEUTONS

The Germans Dedicate Their Handsome New Hall. A GREAT SHOWING IN THE PARADE. Poems, Music, Gymnastics and Good Cheer in General.

GEO. ELPHINSTONE'S NEAT ADDRESS.

The new Allegheny Turner Hall, which has risen up, larger, grander and more beautiful from the ruins of its predecessor, was dedicated yesterday afternoon with appropriate ceremonies.

The parade formed at the corner of Federal street, Allegheny, and at 2 o'clock the column moved. The route was confined almost entirely to Allegheny, and it was handsomely decorated.

FORMATION OF THE PARADE.

The column was headed by three heralds and a platoon of police. The Teutonic singing society headed by the Great Western Band, acted as escort to Chief Marshal John Marshall.

SWINGING 'ROUND THE CIRCLE.

The societies marched over the principal streets on the east side of Federal street, and passed in review at the corner of Main and Chestnut streets, after which they marched to the hall on Chestnut street.

NOTES OF THE OCCASION.

The Allegheny Turn Verein was organized in July, 1861. Its founders and officers were Rev. G. W. Schaeffer, President; J. F. Bechtel, Secretary; Second Soester, J. L. Vauel, Treasurer.

It was nearly a week when the regular dedicatory exercises began, by the Great Western Band playing "Templewail," by Keller-Bela. The selection was supposed to be descriptive of the building of a temple.

It is not generally known, except by the iron men, that the output of iron ore from the Northwest or Lake Superior region, for the season just closed, was away beyond the average for any other year.

Not at the close of navigation last week the output of iron ore from the Northwest for the season was 7,000,000 tons, exceeding the output of last season by 2,000,000 tons.

The prospects of the iron trade, therefore, at present are very bright, and the indications are that iron workers will have a prosperous and cheerful winter.

It is estimated by careful manufacturers that about 4,000,000 tons of this ore reached Pittsburgh markets. The balance was distributed in Michigan, Ohio and elsewhere.

Some of the iron manufacturers who do not own their own lines, are being back to coal, and they help the coal operators a little.
