

GRIEVANCES GET OUT

Local Trainmen on the Western Lines Present a Few Demands.

WANT A REDUCTION IN HOURS,

Double Pay for Sunday Work and Extra Money for Overtime.

A CONFERENCE MAY BE HELD TO-DAY

The following is a copy of grievances presented yesterday by the trainmen to the management of the Pittsburgh and Western road.

First—On and after January 1, 1914, and until December 31, 1914, day yard conductors will be paid \$7 50 a day, ten hours or less to constitute a day's work, all overtime to be paid at the rate of 25 cents per hour, except Sunday work, which shall be paid on the basis of \$4 a day and 40 cents an hour for overtime.

Second—Night yardmen will be paid \$2 90 cents a day; overtime 25 cents per hour; Sunday \$4 50 and 40 cents per hour for overtime.

Third—Day yardmen shall be paid \$3 30 and 40 cents per hour for overtime; Sunday \$4 50 and 40 cents per hour for overtime.

Fourth—Night yardmen shall be paid \$2 90 and 40 cents per hour for overtime; Sunday \$4 50 and 40 cents per hour for overtime.

Fifth—Passenger brakemen will be paid \$2 10 cents a day and 15 cents a mile for all over that distance.

Sixth—Local freight conductors shall be paid \$3 50 per trip of 50 miles or less and at the rate of 25 cents per hour for overtime.

Seventh—Local freight conductors shall be paid \$2 40 per trip of 50 miles and 25 cents per hour for overtime.

Eighth—Local freight brakemen will be paid \$2 30 per trip of 50 miles and 25 cents per hour for overtime.

Ninth—Through freight brakemen shall be paid \$2 20 per trip of 50 miles or less and at the rate of 25 cents per hour for overtime.
