MISREPRESENTATIONS CORRECTED.

The New York and Chicago Tribunes and several other papers, opposed to the re-nomination of General Grant, greatly misrepresented the late contest in the Senate on the subject of creating a committee on investigation of the Civil Service.

The question of standing or special committee was solely incidental. The real and only difference between the Democrats and their pseudo Republican allies and the Republicans was whether said committee should be clothed with the extraordinary power, which no other committee has and which a number of Senators deem unconstitutional of instituting ex parte investigations, without the knowledge of the Senate.


