city and within 50 to 100 miles circuit. The preparation of soil and the location for the orchard, and other matters connected therewith, will form another article. The kinds of fruit (apples) to be planted will depend upon what disposition is to be made of the fruit, when grown. The Early Strawberry is an indispensable to the amateur orchardist, but is unfit for the commercial orchard, on account of its tender flesh and aptitude to bruise in transportation, and look badly when exposed for sale. For the commercial orchard, I will give a list in the order of their ripening—Astrachan Red, Edward's Early, American Sun, Pearmain, Towshend, Early Ripe, Mountain Pearmain, Porter, Maiden's Blush, Fall Pippin, Gravenstein, Northern Spy, Smoke House, Wine, Jersey Sweet, and Hollow Core, or Filly; for winter, Abram, Albemarle, Carr-House, Smith's Cider, Fallowater, Harrison, Limbertwig, Meade's Keeper, Peck's Pleasant, Winter Paradise, Prior's Red, Rawley's Janet, Roman Stem, Ridge Pippin, American Golden Russet, Wine Sap, Winter Crab. Other varieties of Southern fruits are highly spoken of, but I have not yet tested their merits—as the Shockly, Grime's Golden Shockly, &c.

In the discussion of the paper great importance was given to the matter of producing early apples for pecuniary profit. The "wine sap" was made prominent, and received universal praise.

The following recipe is said to be the formula for making the L'Homme-Lefort, or cold grafting wax, now largely imported into this country and which may be had at our leading seed stores:

L'Homme-Lefort, a French gentleman, about the years 1850 to '57, invented, after a series of experiments, a fluid composition, which, for light and value, would, if known, supersede all other means of grafting or covering the wounds of trees and plants, being easily and cheaply prepared, is not affected by the hottest sun or the severest cold, never softens or cracks when exposed to atmospheric changes, is easily applied, and will keep if well corked in wide mouth bottles for months and years unaltered, and was, while the preparation was kept a secret, used by the inventor and his friends. The ingredients and their proportions, together with the modus operandi, are as follows: Of rosin, 1 lb.; of beef tallow, 1 oz.; of spirits of turpentine, 1 tablespoonful; of alcohol (95 per cent.), 5 or 6 ozs.

Melt the rosin over a gentle fire, add to it the beef tallow, and stir well, take from the fire, let it cool down a little, and then mix the spirits of turpentine by little, and at last the alcohol in the same way, using the utmost care to prevent the alcohol from getting inflamed, and its too rapid evaporation from the mass being too hot while adding the alcohol gradually. If it should become too cool or in a viscid lump, it must be slightly heated again. Adding the alcohol will cause some effervescence. This stirring is required to mix the ingredients thoroughly. Keep it in a corked bottle, and put it on with a brush in a thin coat. If too thick, a crust will form, preventing the alcohol from evaporating and the mass from hardening. It is always ready for use, and never affected by heat or cold, healing up all wounds hermetically, and after a few days' exposure it assumes a white color and becomes as hard as stone, impervious to water and air. A single application will last for years.

Before adopting it as the best and most practical, the association desired its trial among the members, when its decision would be pronounced.

The association then adjourned to meet at the Board of Trade Rooms the first Tuesday in June.
