

An Interesting Paper. Chalkley Gillingham, president of the Potomac fruit growers' association, delivered the following address before the last meeting, which will commend itself to the fruit-growers of the state:

FRIENDS OF THE POTOMAC FRUIT GROWERS' ASSOCIATION—Another year of the existence of our organization has rolled around since our last election for officers, and in this lapse of time we have a corresponding progress and improvement in pomological science. It is science we may call it; but I believe it is denied by most scientific men to be such, but only based upon observation and experience; and the greater necessity for closer attention and practical illustrations and experiments.

I take this opportunity to tender my cordial thanks to the members of the association for the great mark of respect shown and reposed in me, by placing me again as the presiding officer of these meetings, composed as they are, of some of the best scientists of this great nation, and, too, at its very capital. I say I do not know how to sufficiently appreciate and repay this great evidence of favor and friendship. It was stated at our last meeting that some greater means should be used to increase the size and interest in these meetings of the association. Well, I will ask you what shall be done in order to effect this; shall we not do our best to effect the discovery as to the best means to instill new life into the collected organization by every member, to consider that each one owes something towards making every meeting useful and interesting, by either having something to exhibit, or some interesting paper to give that will do benefit fruit growing.

If anything more can be done by the presiding officer in any way to forward the work, or to make the meetings of the association more interesting, he can find at the service of the members, if he can find out what that would be; he does not flatter himself with having an intimate knowledge of pomological science. Well, I will ask you what shall be done in order to effect this; shall we not do our best to effect the discovery as to the best means to instill new life into the collected organization by every member, to consider that each one owes something towards making every meeting useful and interesting, by either having something to exhibit, or some interesting paper to give that will do benefit fruit growing.

make a few extracts from the address of the veteran pomologist, Mr. Will P. Wilder, delivered before that American pomological society, at its biennial meeting at Richmond, Virginia, in the autumn of 1871. "I would suggest (said he) that it is desirable for us to gather up for future use the lessons which have been acquired by the experience of the past. We have been busy in accumulating knowledge in the various branches of pomology, but we have had no time to look back and to systematize the inferences and deductions to be drawn from our operations. But we believe the time has now come when we should pause and survey the field and make a review of the lessons which science has taught; for science is but a statement of the facts of progress, systematized and tried in different localities and in the grains of sand that roll up the mountains, the drops of water that make the ocean, and it is lesson upon lesson, fact upon fact, which must build up the science which we wish to create. Nothing in the present age astonishes us more than the wonderful power of association, the centralization of thought and action for the production of particular objects, and the concentration of individuals and diffusing this knowledge for the benefit of the world. How clearly is this seen in the operations of our own society—how great the changes and how rapid the progress since its formation! Now its list of members was 107, now its roll contains the names of 312 persons. Then its sphere of operations was confined by the boundaries of a few states, now it extends from ocean to ocean, from the provinces to the gulf, and wherever the foot of civilization rests in our broad domain. Nor is it too much to say that in this space of time more progress has been made in the science of pomology than in the whole period since the settlement of our country. Never before was the interest so engrossing or so widely extended."

INSECTS AND DISEASES. The subject of insects and disease is daily attracting more attention, for their depredations are becoming more and more evil, and the importance of entomological investigation is every day more plainly seen. It is less than fifty years since Dr. Harris first published his work on "Insect Injuries to Vegetation," and great is the debt of gratitude which we owe to him, and to the succeeding investigators who have given their lives to studying the habits of the various species of insects, and their enemies. On this subject, the words of Edmund Burke are appropriate: "The most vigilant superintendance; the most prompt activity, which has no such day as to-morrow in its calendar, are necessary to the farmer," and we may add, still more so to the fruit-grower, and ten-fold more necessary to combating our insect enemies. The neglect in battling with these vile creatures is the great bane of successful cultivation; but as long as moral evil exists in the world, so long may we expect there will be evil in the natural world, and he who is not willing to contend against both is not worthy of the name of either cultivator or Christian.

We belong to that class who have faith in the ultimate triumph of good over evil in the natural world, and we are confident, least strong that the insect plagues shall, if not exterminated, at least be subdued, so that the labor of keeping them so far in check that no material harm shall be caused by them, will be comparatively easy. We have discovered means for preventing the ravages of the currant worm, curculion, canker worm, caterpillar, melon bug and aphid, and the new and other diseases of vines. If we can do this, is it not reasonable to suppose that we can discover remedies for, or the means of preventing all the diseases and depredations that vegetation is liable to? Is it consistent with that Divine economy, so benevolent in all its ways and works, to believe that this fair creation has been spread out only to be destroyed; that seed time should be sown in vain, and that the harvest should be lost? Is it consistent with that Divine Providence which created all things, and pronounced them very good?

If any one say it is of no use to contend with these horrid vile creatures, or the disappointments upon which all culture is based, let him remember that it is the mission of life to struggle against and overcome them. Instead of fretting and groaning over these evils, let us battle with them and conquer them. Thus shall we gather the rich fruits of our industry, and "Where some would find thorns but to torture the flesh."

Will pick the ripe clusters our souls to refresh."

Many of the difficulties and privations we endure if met and conquered, will prove blessings in disguise. It is a labor of mind as well as body; it is a strong work, work that makes men strong. Work is the great engine that molds and moves the intellect, enterprise, and destiny of the world; work is the greatest temporal boon bestowed upon man; work is the heaven-appointed means of advancement to a higher state of perfection, and in no profession is this more apparent than in the calling of the pomologist. This idea is well expressed in the following lines, illustrative of the blessings of labor:

"The first man and the first of men, Were tillers of the soil, And that was mercy's mandate then, Which destined man to toil." Much more copious extracts should be taken from this very valuable address, but which will have to be left for a future occasion; but before the subject of labor upon this subject is dismissed, I would like to introduce another short article upon the subject, from the pen of the noted Belgian pomologist, Dr. Van Mons. In speaking of producing new varieties of fruits, and of improving and perfecting the present ones from seeds, he says: "To sow, to resow, to sow again, to sow perpetually, in short, to do nothing but sow, is the practice to be pursued, and which cannot be departed from, and in this is the whole secret I have employed."

There are many other subjects connected with pomology or fruit growing, as brought into view through the American society from time to time, which should claim our attention, but is hardly expected to be introduced in an inaugural address, but may form a series of articles to be presented from time to time, one of which is the entire inability to judge correctly of the kind of fruit exhibited from a single specimen, or even two or three, and particularly when grown in different localities and soils, hence the very many incorrectly named fruits, as shown at our last meeting.
