Oat meal was first considered. The meal is ordered in Baltimore, and costs, delivered in Alexandria, \$54 per ton in sacks. By practical experiment two to four pounds of oat meal is equal to five pounds of corn.

Plaster—Subscriptions were received at \$5.50 per ton. Several tons were taken. It was the general opinion that plaster did best on land in good heart, and containing more or less potash.

Gas lime can be obtained, exclusive of freight, at 2 1/2 cents per bushel of 40,000 bushels are taken. Books were opened and subscriptions commenced.

A Correction—Mr. Ferrigo at last meeting said he should plow seed land in the Fall or let it till late in the Spring, not let it lay until the next Fall.

George Waring's letter in reply to the comparison of his words in Elements of Agriculture with those of the Agriculturist, explains the apparent difference, and shows that in both cases, while recognizing the advantages of deep plowing, he recommends care in its excessive practice in this soil.
