These islands are however, much closer to this country than they are to Spain or Denmark, and are from their geographical situation naturally more a part of America than of Europe.

In a naval point of view they would doubtless prove of incalculable benefit to the United States should this country again cross swords with a foreign power.



SCENE IN A PORTUGAL VINEYARD

In the mountains, at the Quinto de Seabra, Portugal, a famous Port Wine district where the custom of treading the grapes for Port Wine is still in vogue. From ten to a dozen men or women of each gang in turn continue the treading, day and night, during the four or five weeks vintage. Some of the treading vats are large enough for three separate rows of ten men each, who with their wicker hoes well tucked up, their arms on each other's shoulders, and tread their feet alternately, with song and shouts to keep the laborious up to the work, and a band with string instruments entertains the hoats.
