Speech of Hon. Henry St. George Tucker

The House being in Committee of the Whole, and having under consideration the bill (H. R. 916) to reduce the revenue and equitize duties on imports.

Mr. Tucker said: The bill before me is an amendment on Saturday evening abolishing the present system of taxation on tobacco, and offered it in entire good faith.

By the imposition and continuation of this tax the tobacco lands in Virginia are greatly depreciating in value and the crop is gradually diminishing, and the result is that the people are losing their power to confiscate the lands of the people.

But see how unjustly this bill deals with tobacco in comparison with two other agricultural products and sugar. The tobacco is retained at 4 cents per pound—this is trifling with the people, for they demand its total abolition.

And on the subject of the sugar bounty, the bill proposes to admit free of duty all sugar up to and including 2 cents per pound on this country's production.
