

Trans-Continental Railway of the South

It is gratifying to see a smart increase of popularity of the Southern trans-continental line—that known as the Texas-Pacific railway. It cannot be exaggerated in importance to the nation, and should be hailed with entire approbation by the South as necessary to complete the equal distribution of facilities for trans-continental communication between the North and the South.

In a military sense, the southern line is preeminently important, because the southern border is more fruitful of danger than the northern, which is held in the bonds of peace by the embargo of frost and the absence of those resources which are the objects of conflict.

We have been for years an enthusiastic advocate of a trans-continental route near our southern border for these high considerations. They should override all minor questions of State-policy and State-rights fastidiousness.
