Nugget That Started Stampede Given to Historical Library

Helena, Jan. 15.—The gold nugget that resulted in the stampede to Alder gulch and the settlement and development of this state, the first gold in what is now Montana, has been presented to the State Historical Library by Mrs. Granville Stuart, whose brother-in-law, James Stuart, picked the nugget up on Gold creek, just west of the main range of the Rockies, May 21, 1862.
