

FEDERAL COURT TO OPEN TODAY

Grand Jury to Be Empanelled and Charge to Members at 10 a. m.

The adjourned February term, sometimes called the grand jury term, of the United States district court, for the

district of Montana, division of Great Falls, will be convened by Judge George M. Bourquin of Butte at 10 a. m. today. The grand jury will report at that hour, will be impanelled and charged by the court.

NESS ESTATE MAY MAKE LITIGATION

Litigation growing out of probate of the will of the late Julius O. Ness is commented upon in court circles as being within the range of possibilities.

Julius Ness was murdered by his wife late in December, she dying a few days later from self-inflicted injuries. Mrs. Ness made the sole beneficiary in her husband's will, and just prior to her death she executed a will in which her relatives were instructed to receive all the property coming to her from Mr. Ness.

NESS ESTATE MAY MAKE LITIGATION

The estate, including life insurance, is valued at something less than \$25,000. The act of Mrs. Ness was regarded as that of any insane person and persons who have expressed laymen's opinions on the case have contended she was not mentally sound and therefore was not competent to dispose of property at the time her will was made.
