KOUHOSIS GIVEN 10 DAYS IN JAIL

Bootlegger at the Thannhouser Must Also Pay a Fine of \$100 for His Act.

A fine of \$100 and a 10-day jail sentence was the penalty imposed in district court yesterday on Steve Kouhosis for selling whisky at the Thannhouser Bar in violation of the prohibition law. Kouhosis pled guilty to the charge when he was arraigned before Judge H. H. Ewing and it was said yesterday that he will return to his former job at the smelter as soon as he ceases to be a guest of Sheriff J. P. Burns.

Kouhosis recently took over the lease on the Thannhouser, paying \$65 for the layout. That he was selling liquor was suspected a short time later and one night Deputy Sheriff E. J. Tait was sold a drink over the bar and also a couple of bottles, the proprietor's arrest following. Frank Spencer, the bartender, gave Sheriff Burns a description of the way in which liquor was brot to the place and sold and it is believed that with Kouhosis' conviction the most flagrant violation of the prohibition law so far coming to the attention of officials has been detected and discontinued.

The door of the Thannhouser was locked at the night of the bartender's arrest and abatement proceedings will probably be filed against the building by County Attorney H. G. Bennet.
