

New York, May 21.—The feature in today's dealings was the severe decline in Marine common, the selling in this issue being promoted by disappointment expressed in many circles over the status of the Junior shares, notwithstanding the report that the much-talked-of deal which the British government has been generally believed, secured more at the meeting of the Marine stock holders in June was also a factor.

Paris, May 21.—(Havas)—In addition to the abandonment of the project of trip to England of General Pershing, the American command-in-chief, several of the highest officers of the expedition and certain members of the American peace mission, according to reports, have given up the idea of a return to America in the near future.

WAGE INCREASE FOR 150,000 TEXTILE WORKERS

Boston, May 21.—Wage increases affecting upwards of 150,000 textile operatives in New England and other northern states were made public today. In most instances the advance was announced as approximately 15 per cent. Both cotton and woolen mills are affected.

ENGLAND OPENS DOORS TO 75 ARTICLES OF IMPORT

Washington, May 21.—Announcement was made today at the British embassy that Great Britain has issued general licenses authorizing the importation into England of 75 articles of commerce. At the same time prohibition has been laid upon the importation into the United Kingdom of various forms of potato salts and saccharine and its mixtures.
