EASTER WEEK CLASH SOUNDS KNELL OF THE IRISH LANGUAGE. Dublin, June 29.—The Irish language is dying, Desmond Fitzgerald, author and member of the Sinn Fein, told the members of that organization in a pessimistic speech at the Sinn Fein headquarters. Mr. Fitzgerald said the Irish language had been dying since Easter week last year when the Sinn Fein clash with the authorities took place in Dublin. Speaking of the wearing of the Irish kilt, he said he could not imagine the Irish people wearing it at work in the fields. He regarded the separation of Ireland from England as more urgent culturally than politically.
