

PLAY BY INNINGS THAT GAVE REDS EIGHTH GAME IN WORLD SERIES

First Inning—First Half.
Rath up. Strike one. Strike two. It was a foul. Rath opened the contest with a pop fly that Risberg got in short left. Daubert up. Strike one. Daubert singled to center. It was a line drive that Liebold made a great effort for, but could not quite reach before it touched the ground. Groh up. Strike one. Groh fouled the first one off. Ball one. Foul strike two. Groh fouled the third ball into the left field pavilion. Groh singled to right. It was a short hit that cleared over first base, and Daubert held second. Roush up. Strike one. Strike one. Roush doubled past first base to the right field pavilion fence, scoring Daubert, and putting Groh on third. Duncan up. James is warming up for Chicago. Foul strike one. Ball one. Duncan fouled to left, scoring Groh and Roush. It was a line drive that went over Weaver's head and Jackson fielded in the extreme left field corner. This was enough for Williams, "Big Bill" James got into the box for Gleason's team. Kopf up. Ball one. Ball two. Strike one. Ball three. James could not locate the plate properly and walked Kopf. Duncan retained second. Neale up. Strike one. Strike two. Neale took a terrific swing at the second strike but missed. Ball one. Neale fanned. The third ball was called on him. Rariden up. Ball one. James almost made a wild pitch, but Schalk covered the ball before any damage could be done. Rariden lofted a Texas leaguer hit over first base scoring Duncan and putting Kopf on third. Eller up. The crowd gave Eller a great ovation when he went into the batters' box. Foul strike one. Ball one. Rariden stole second. Ball two. Eller ended the inning by flying out to Felsch. Four runs, five hits, no errors.

First Inning—Second Half.
The Reds displayed the most consecutive hitting in the series in this inning. Their wallpops off Williams were all clean hits. Liebold up. Strike one. Eller's first pitch was over the pan. Liebold started for the Sox with a clean single to left that Duncan fielded. Liebold and prevented him from stretching into a double. Ed Collins up. Strike one. Ball one. Ed Collins singled to left. Duncan fumbled the hit and Ed Collins reached second while Liebold went to third. Ed Collins given a double on the drive and error against Duncan eliminated. Official scorer's ruling. Weaver up. Ball one. Strike one. Strike two. Weaver fanned. Eller got his first victim when he slipped the third strike over on Weaver. Jackson up. Jackson lifted a puny fly that Kopf captured in back of third. Liebold holding third and Ed Collins second. Felsch up. Strike two. Felsch tried to dodge the ball but it hit his bat. Strike two. He swung at the second one but failed to connect. Foul. Ball one. Second Inning—First Half.
Rath up. Strike one. Strike two. Ball one. Ball two. Ball three. Rath struck out. James got Rath in the third and two hole and bounced on fair ground on him. Daubert up. Ball one. Daubert flied out to Jackson who got the ball after a short run. Groh up. Strike one. Groh called for the ball and examined it but the umpire ruled it was a foul. Foul strike two. Ball one. Ball two. Ball three. Groh singled to Gandil. The ball went back of first. Groh turned his ankle when he stepped on first and play was delayed for a few minutes, but he resumed and took his position on first base. Roush up. Ball one. Ball two. Roush doubled to left field, scoring Groh on the hit, but Roush was caught between second and third while Liebold threw to Risberg and in the rundown Schalk and Weaver got assists while Ed Collins finally put the ball on him. One run, two hits, no errors.

Second Inning—Second Half.
Gandil up. Ball one. Strike one. Gandil flied to Daubert. Risberg up. Ball one. Ball two. Ball three. Strike one. Eller had trouble locating the plate and walked Risberg. Again the ball was examined by Schalk and the umpire but it was returned to Eller. Schalk up. Ball one. Rariden dropped Schalk's high foot and was given an error. Strike one. Strike two. Foul. Foul. Schalk again wanted the umpire to examine the ball and he tossed it back to Eller. Ball two. Schalk singled to left. Duncan came in fast but the ball hit the ground first. Risberg reaching second. James up. James hit a high foul to Groh, and neither base runner advanced. Liebold up. Strike one. Strike two. Foul strike two. Ball two. Liebold struck out, taking a healthy swing at the last one, and hitting only atmosphere. No runs, one hit, one error.

Third Inning—First Half.
Duncan up. Strike one. Weaver took Duncan's high rounder and threw him out at first. Kopf up. Strike one. Ball one. Weaver came over first. Kopf's grounder and throwing to Gandil for the put out. Neale up. Ball one. Ball two. Foul strike one. Ball three. Strike two. Foul strike two. Foul. Neale, thinking the ball had been touched before it rolled foul, stayed on first and the

crowd booed him. He resumed his place in the batters' box and fouled the next ball. He then drew his foul ball and walked. Rariden up. Strike one. Strike two. Ball one. Neale was caught stealing. Schalk to Ed Collins. No runs, no hits, no errors.

Third Inning—Second Half.
Ed Collins up. Ball one. Strike one. Foul strike two. Ball two. Ed Collins flied to Duncan. It was a hard drive, but almost directly into the hands of the Red left fielder. Weaver up. Ball one. Weaver hoisted a high fly that Rath made a circus catch of, going back and barely getting it. Jackson up. Ball one. The outfielders moved back for Jackson and he sent one into the right field bleachers for a home run. It was the longest hit made during the series at this park. Neale, who was playing deep, backed up to the fence and waited for the ball to go over his head. Felsch up. Kopf took Felsch's grounder and tossed to Daubert for the third out. One run, one hit, no errors.

The crowd gave Jackson a big hand as he took his place in left field.

Fourth Inning—First Half.
Rariden up. Rariden lined into Gandil's hand for the first out. Eller up. Eller was hit by the first pitched ball and trotted to first. Rath up. Foul strike one. Rath attempted to sacrifice but the ball rolled foul. Ball one. Foul strike two. Ball two. Rath singled to second base. Risberg managing to stop it, but could not recover it in time for a putout. Eller taking second. Daubert up. Ball one. Foul strike one. Ball two. Daubert singled to center and Eller was caught at the plate when Liebold made a wonderful throw to Schalk. Rath reached third and Daubert took second on the throw to the plate. Groh popped out to Ed Collins. No runs, two hits, no errors.

Fourth Inning—Second Half.
Gandil up. Gandil hoisted to Neale, who caught the ball in right center while on a full run. Risberg up. Strike one. Ball one. Ball two. Strike two. Risberg struck out, the last strike being a foul tip that Rariden held on to. Schalk up. Strike one. Foul strike two. Groh gathered in Schalk's grounder and threw him out at first. No runs, no hits, no errors.

Fifth Inning—First Half.
Roush up. Ed Collins got Roush's grounder and threw to Gandil for the put out. Duncan up. Ball one. Duncan line flied to Ed Collins. It was a wicked drive that Collins speared. Kopf up. Ball one. Kopf tripped to right, the ball going over first base and reaching the extreme right field corner before Felsch retrieved it. Neale up. Ball one. Strike one. Foul strike two. Neale singled between third and short and Kopf scored. Rariden up. Rariden examined the ball and then threw it back to James. Ball one. Neale stole second. Schalk's throw was a little to the left of the bag. James almost caught Neale with a quick throw to second. Foul, strike one. Foul, strike two. Risberg threw Rariden out at first. One run, two hits, no errors.

Fifth Inning—Second Half.
James up. Strike one. Strike two. Foul. Foul. James fouled one that hit his foot and bounced on fair ground. The umpire called it foul. Foul. James struck out. Liebold up. Kopf made a great stop of Liebold's grass cutter and got the ball over to first ahead of the runner. Ed Collins up. Ball one. Kopf also took Ed Collins' grounder and threw to first for the put out. No runs, no hits, no errors.

Sixth Inning—First Half.
Eller up. Ball one. Strike one. Eller

singled through the box. Rath up. Every Cincinnati player has now made at least one hit. Ball one. Ball two. Ball three. Strike one. Strike two. James got Rath in the third and two hole and then walked him by pitching one wide over first, the ball taking a nasty bound and hitting Daubert on the shins. Jackson up. Foul strike one. Jackson hoisted a long fly that Roush got. Roush was playing extremely deep. Felsch up. Foul. Ball one. Roush also took care of Felsch's high fly. Gandil up. Foul strike one. Ball one. Neale camped under Gandil's fly and captured it. No runs, one hit, no errors.

Sixth Inning—Second Half.
Weaver up. Foul strike one. Foul strike two. Ball one. Weaver singled over first, the ball taking a nasty bound and hitting Daubert on the shins. Jackson up. Foul strike one. Jackson hoisted a long fly that Roush got. Roush was playing extremely deep. Felsch up. Foul. Ball one. Roush also took care of Felsch's high fly. Gandil up. Foul strike one. Ball one. Neale camped under Gandil's fly and captured it. No runs, one hit, no errors.

Seventh Inning, First Half.

Ball one. Ball two. Strike one. Ball three. Strike two. Ball four. Eller walked. Daubert up. Ball one. Strike one. Foul, strike two. Ball two. Rath stole second. He got off to a good lead and beat the throw. Ball three. Daubert also walked. Wilkinson was wild at this juncture. Groh up. Groh hoisted to Liebold for the third out. No runs, no

hits, no errors.

Seventh Inning, Second Half.
Risberg up. Ball one. Foul, strike one. Ball two. Strike two. Foul. Foul. Risberg hoisted one to Rath in short right center. Schalk up. Ball one. Foul. Schalk lifted a high foul that Rariden got under and caught. Wilkinson up. Strike one. Ball one. Ball two. Strike two. Wilkinson struck out. No runs, no errors. Eller appeared to be growing stronger as the game progressed.

Eighth Inning, First Half.
Roush up. Strike one. Roush was hit by the second ball pitched and walked to first. Wilkinson claimed he was not hit but the claim was disallowed. Duncan sacrificed. Wilkinson to Gandil. Kopf up. Kopf hoisted a foul to Weaver. Neale up. Ball one. Strike one. Ball two. Ball three. Strike two. Foul. Foul. Neale walked, after getting Wilkinson in the third and two hole, he drew another bad one and walked. Rariden up. Ball one. Rariden singled and Roush scored. Neale reaching third and Rariden second on Jackson's throw to the plate. Eller up. Risberg threw out Eller at first, making a pretty throw from deep short. One run, one hit, no errors.

Eighth Inning, Second Half.
Liebold up. Ball one. Strike one. Strike two. Ball one. Foul. Ball three. Liebold arched a fly to Neale in deep right. Ed Collins up. Ed Collins singled through the pitcher's box. Roush retrieving it. Weaver up. Foul strike one. Ball one. Foul strike two. Foul. Field box seats, putting Ed Collins on

third. Jackson up. The outfield again moved back for Jackson. Ball one. Jackson doubled to right, scoring Ed Collins and Weaver. It was a hard line drive. Felsch up. Felsch popped an easy one to Daubert and Jackson held second. Gandil up. Gandil tripled to right field, Jackson scoring. Neale lost the ball in the sun and it landed fully 30 feet away from him. He did not locate it until it hit the ground. Risberg up. Strike one. Ball one. Strike two. Roush fumbled Risberg's fly, Gandil trotting across the plate. Roush wavered when the ball got into the sun, but finally got to it and then made a fumble. Schalk up. Rath tossed out Schalk at first. Four runs, four hits, one error.

Ninth Inning, First Half.
Rath up. Ball one. Rath singled over second, Risberg managing to knock down his grounder, but could not get to first in time. Daubert up. Daubert sacrificed. Wilkinson to Gandil. Rath taking second. Groh up. Strike one. Ball one. Groh hoisted to Liebold, Rath holding second. Roush up. Weaver threw out Roush, Gandil taking the throw.

No runs, one hit, no errors.

Ninth Inning, Second Half.
Murphy batted for Wilkinson. Murphy up. Ball one. Ball two. Murphy was hit by the third pitched ball and walked to first. The crowd was in an uproar. Liebold up. Ball one. Ball two. Strike one. Roush made a circus catch of Liebold's fly, getting to it and turning a somersault, holding the ball. Murphy held first. Ed Collins up. Strike one. Ball one. Foul strike two. Foul. Ed Collins singled to center, Murphy go-

ing to second. Weaver up. The umpire again examined the ball and tossed it back to Eller. Neale grabbed Weaver's fly, but Murphy made third after the catch. Ed Collins held first. Jackson up. Strike one. Ed Collins stole second. Strike two. Ball one. Foul. Rath threw out Jackson at first. No runs, one hit, no errors.

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
