YEAR FOR SPECK**

Former Great Northern Pay-
master Pleads Guilty to Grand
Larceny Charge.

Rudolph J. Speck, former paymaster at the Great Northern offices in this city, pleaded guilty to grand larceny before Judge J. B. Leslie in district court Thursday and was sentenced to serve not less than one nor more than two years in the state penitentiary. The charge to which Speck pleaded guilty grew out of the misappropriation of funds in the department of which he was the head. His arrest followed an investigation by railroad officials, the allegation being made by Great Northern detectives that Speck diverted the checks of absent employees into his working fund and appropriated for his own use an equal amount of cash. Between \$800 and \$1,000 was alleged to have been obtained in this way by Speck.

After pleading guilty, Speck asked the court to grant him a parole but the request was denied. Judge Leslie stated that the legislature had granted the right to recommendation of sentence in cases where the circumstances seemed to justify that action, but that there was no disposition on the part of this court to abuse the privilege.

Speck is 28 years of age and before his arrest last August had been identified with disturbances on the south side. He was once arrested for allowing misconduct in his home, forfeiting bail rather than answer to the charge in police court. Great Northern detectives assert that the money obtained wrongfully from the company was spent in high living.




