GROWING DANCE OF PLANT CAST UPON SCREEN

Display Device Has 100,000-Fold Powers of Microscope.

London, Dec. 28.—An audience seated in the council chamber of the India office watched the growth of a plant and the effects of various stimulants upon it, as recorded on the screen by a cinematograph, a recent invention of an Indian savant, Sir Jagadis Chandra Bose, who gave the demonstration.

The cinematograph is composed of a single magnet lever which, by its movements rotates a delicately poised needle actuating a small mirror. This causes a spot of light to be reflected upon the screen, giving a magnification of from one million to one hundred million times. It is tantamount, said the lecturers, to magnifying the highest powers of a microscope 100,000 times.

Upon the room being darkened a mysterious "hook" of light passes rapidly across the screen. It showed the actual growth of plant as projected from the cinematograph. Subsequently the hook appeared slowed down in its course across the screen and finally halted. This, the lecturer said, illustrated the effect of electricity upon the plant, to magnifying the growth of the plant to the stimulation afforded by a reasonable amount.

Particularly interesting was the record showing the erratic effects in the growth of a plant caused by use of alcohol. Sir Jagadis pointed out that the growth of a plant was thus made subservient to the will of the grower and by experimenting in this direction in regard to agricultural matters, discoveries of vast importance might be made. By use of the cinematograph, he added there was no need to wait a whole season as at present to witness the results of experiments.

\$200,000 Brood Mare Has Five Attendants on Trip From France

New York, Dec. 28.—With a retinue of attendants worthy of a prince of the blood, including a doctor to supervise her diet, the brood mare Sweet Briar, valued at \$200,000, has arrived here on the Atlantic transport steamer Michigan from France after a stormy three weeks' voyage.

Mr. Korine says it will be impossible to make up the shortage before 1927. He also reported that the Union stockyards for the year 1919 or 1918 is reported. Cattle receipts, however, decreased 290,000. Decreases in cattle slaughtered are also reported at the markets in Kansas City, Omaha, St. Joseph, St. Louis and Sioux City.
