Tobacco pipes are being made in Australia from native woods, comparing favorably to the woods more generally used.

Engineless airplanes to be towed behind planes equipped with motors are promised by a noted European builder of aircraft.

A Texas lumberman is the inventor of a portable electrically driven buzz saw for felling trees and cutting them into logs.

Panama canal traffic in October exceeded that of any previous month in net tonnage of commercial vessels using the waterway.

Scientists have estimated that London's annual fall of soot is equivalent to from 25 to 35 pounds for each inhabitant of the city.

Driven by a 300-horsepower electric motor, a stone crusher in a Michigan limestone plant can crush 1250 tons of rock an hour.

The pumps of a fire boat purchased by the Italian government for use in Naples harbor can throw 1245 tons of water an hour.

On one leg of new culverts is a curved scale along which a hand is moved by a geared segment to accurately show measurements made.

An extremely durable textile for clothing has been developed in England from short silk fibres heretofore thought almost worthless.

A new grease gun for automobiles is operated by compressed air obtained from a tire pump or even an inflated tire carried as a spare.

In the Paris observatory clocks are kept 90 feet underground, where the temperature has varied less than one degree in several years.

Russia is estimated to have about 25,000,000 horses, more than any other country, the United States ranking second with nearly 24,000,000.

Leather covers to protect the front fenders of an automobile while repairs are being made under the hood have been invented for use in garages.

The interior of some passenger cars on the Egyptian state railway is cooled by tanks of ice, from which the air is circulated by electric fans.

For removing water from submerged ships a motor driven pump has been invented that can be operated at depths beyond the capacity of steam pumps.

The government of Denmark and Sweden have been investigating deposits of coal discovered on the Danish island of Bornholm, near the Swedish coast.

Ice skating without ice has been made possible by a New Yorker, who has invented skates with a number of rollers set beneath the blades.

Two French scientists have found that X-ray screens made of a compound of tungsten and cadmium give better results than platinum ones at far less cost.

A British metallurgist believes he has rediscovered the secret of the ancient Spanish armorers in producing a tarnish proof steel that even resists acids.

The drawers in a new kitchen cabinet are enclosed in one large drawer that can be pulled forward for easy access when the table top of the cabinet is extended.

In Norway a dry dock has been built in such a location in reference to a canal that it can be filled with water and emptied by gravity without the use of pumps.

A new pump for spraying flowers or fruits is operated by attaching it to an ordinary fruit jar, several of which can be provided to hold different spraying solutions.

The British government has established an air mail service between London and Paris, with extension by train to the remainder of France, Italy, Switzerland and Spain.

For testing the air in closed rooms a lamp has been invented in which there is a special candle that burns dimly or is extinguished as the supply of oxygen in a room diminishes.
