CARNEGIE'S OFFER.

As soon as it was announced in Washington that Andrew Carnegie had put a steel point on his educational gift to the government, by offering steel trust stock instead of cash, there was a strenuous disapproval of accepting it by senators and congressmen, and when President Roosevelt reached out and felt the public pulse he was not long in re-using the offer. The consensus of Washington opinion is said to have been expressed by a prominent senator when he said:

"If congress were to accept Mr. Carnegie's gift of \$10,000,000 of steel trust certificates it would in a sense put the seal of its official approval upon that trust. The fact that Mr. Carnegie's offering is in trust stock means that it presents ten million reasons why congress cannot accept it. The Attorney General of the United States has been asked to prosecute that trust as a violator of federal laws. He has refused to do it. At this very moment his nomination to be Attorney General, not yet confirmed, is under the scrutiny of the senate, and one of the charges brought against him is that he has failed to do his duty in prosecuting that trust. It is further charged that before he was nominated for Attorney General by President McKinley he advised the organizers of this trust how to violate the law and escape punishment. Under these circumstances, how could congress accept in the name of the government a trusteeship of the securities of that corporation? It is impossible."

AN OLD BUT IMPORTANT QUESTION.

There is not a town or city in the United States as large as Bisbee which is not under the control of a city government. Bisbee is conceded to have a population of more than seven thousand, and the fact that no city government has been provided is a surprise to all strangers coming into our midst.

That Bisbee has not been incorporated long ago cannot be laid to the fact that our people are not progressive, as there is not a more public spirited people to be found in the west, east, north or south. But still the fact remains that our people have been unable heretofore to agree on the proposition to incorporate Bisbee.

We believe our people are all sincere in their beliefs on this question, still those who oppose it are doing so from an entirely erroneous standpoint. The incorporation of Bisbee would be a progressive step as well as a beneficial one. It would enable our people to carry on their improvements in order and under regulation, and with an equal burden to all interested.

The question of additional taxation should not stand in the way, because the benefits to be derived would more than compensate the property owners. Let the friends of incorporation continue to urge the proposition with earnestness and we believe that at an early day a practically harmonious consent can be obtained for city incorporation.
