WASHINGTON, JAN. 10.—PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT FAVORS THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE ACTION LOOKING TO REVISION BY CONGRESS OF THE PRESENT TARIFF LAWS. HE INFORMED THE LEADERS OF HIS PARTY, COMPRISING SENATORS AND REPRESENTATIVES WHO WERE INVITED TO A CONFERENCE WITH HIM AT THE WHITE HOUSE ON SATURDAY LAST, AND HE HAS MADE PLAIN HIS DECISION TO OTHERS SINCE THAT CONFERENCE. HE WILL CALL THE FIFTY-NINTH CONGRESS INTO EXTRAORDINARY SESSION AS SOON AS THE COMMITTEES HAVE INDICATED THAT THEY ARE PREPARED TO SUBMIT A TARIFF MEASURE FOR PASSAGE. IT IS KNOWN THAT THE PRESIDENT HAS DECIDED ON THIS COURSE FOR HIS PARTY IN THE FACE OF VIOLENT OPPOSITION FROM THE EASTERN SENATORS, WHO ARE OUTSPOKEN IN THE DECLARATION THAT SUCH A POLICY WILL BRING ON ANOTHER FINANCIAL PANIC AND THAT SECURITIES AND STOCKS WILL TUMBLE. ROOSEVELT DESIRES TO POSE AS THE PROGRESSIVE LEADER OF HIS PARTY, AND PROPOSES TO STICK TO TARIFF REFORM REGARDLESS OF THE OPPOSITION OF EASTERN SENATORS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF HIS OWN PARTY.
