## TERRITORIAL BOARD IS TO BLAME

FOR ONLY LOWERING MADE IN COCHISE ASSESSED VALUATIONS.

Eliminated Railroad Sidings—Comparative Statement of Copper Queen Increased Valuations—New Pay Day Arrangement.

Chairman Bowen, of the Board of Supervisors, yesterday signed vouchers in this city for over three thousand dollars due to county officials and their office help for work performed in the month of July. The vouchers were sent back to Clerk Howe, of the board, by express last evening, and will be cashed today at Tombstone by those in whose favor they are drawn.

The proceedings of yesterday was the first of the kind that has been made in the county, and came about through a rule adopted by the board at its last meeting. Under this rule, which is based on an act of the last legislature, giving to boards of supervisors privilege to authorize payment of the salaries of office employees of the county either by the month or quarterly, the Cochise county supervisors provided that salaries shall be paid monthly. Heretofore payment has been made quarterly, the board auditing the accounts in regular session, and then authorizing payment. As it now is the vouchers are sent to the chairman of the board in this city to be examined and signed. The change, would help the several county offices to keep a less varying force of help, and would also be a great convenience to many of the county office employees at small salaries who have in the past been much inconvenienced by the quarterly pay plan. In concluding his remarks Chairman Bowen drew attention to the abstract of the assessment roll recently forwarded to the territorial board of equalization.

"Here is a copy of the abstract which the Review printed the other morning," he said, "with a note appended from Clerk Howe which says: 'The only thing that shows a decrease on our assessment roll this year is the decrease of \$50,148.09 made by the territorial board in its assessment put on railroad property in the county. It seems to me to be absurd that such a decrease should be made. Right here in Bisbee spurs have been built in the last year which cost the E. P. & S. W. more than \$100,000. The road turned in 25 miles of new siding for assessment, but as I understand it the board had no return of sidings from the Southern Pacific, so it just lopped off the E. P. & S. W. returns of sidings. That is where we get the decrease of better than \$50,000. Then the territorial board has the nerve to send the Cochise county board a letter saying that the county board has not put the mines and cattle values high enough.'"

## JURY ACQUITTED OVERAKER BOY

ACCEPTED HIS STORY THAT HE FOUND CAPS AND FUSE IN ROADWAY.

Said Materials Were Dropped By Some One Who Broke Into Store House. Illegal Storage of Caps and Dynamite Alleged.

A jury in the court of Justice McDonald yesterday afternoon promptly acquitted Eddy Overaker, the ten-year-old who was charged by Superintendent Harland of the Bisbee-Arizona with stealing fuse and caps from the store house of the property about eight miles out Tombstone Canyon.

Present in the court with the boy was his father, George Overaker, a well known resident of Lowell, who is in the employ of the Bisbee Transfer company, and has for years borne a good reputation in the camp. Attorney Baker defended the boy, while Attorney Cunningham appeared for the prosecution, the aim of which was to secure the incarceration of the boy in the Industrial School at Benson.

In the examination it was brought out that the boy had worked at the Bisbee-Arizona property prior to the time of the alleged theft, and had performed the tasks set him in satisfactory manner. The accusation of theft of the caps and fuse, and the belief expressed by the mine people that the boy had been guilty of numerous other thefts that had occurred about the property, was due to the fact that the boy was caught riding away with the materials first mentioned in his possession. In court he explained that he had found the caps and fuse in the road near the store house and had picked them up as he was riding by on a burro. When confronted a few minutes later by the mine people he alleged that they frightened him so that he was unable to make any explanation.

Testimony introduced brought out the fact that it has been the custom to keep dynamite, fuse and caps all in one room at the Bisbee-Arizona store house. It was usual, it was said, to have as high as 250 pounds of dynamite, six boxes of caps and several hundred feet of fuse thus unlawfully thrown together. Following trial of the boy it was said that charges would probably be filed against Superintendent Harland for not keeping his dynamite and caps in separate places. Failure to do this in the territory is punishable by a heavy fine.

## DOOMED MURDERER PROTESTS INNOCENCE

"CHAPPO"EREDIA MAKES STATEMENT REITERATING HE WILL BE HUNG FOR ANOTHER'S CRIME.

Appears to Be Without Hope of Clemency and Says He will Die Bravely—Grief Stricken Sisters Call Daily On Man.

"Chappo" Eredia, the Mexican whose hanging at Tombstone on Friday a week is now about prepared for, has practically given up hope of a reprieve or commutation of his sentence. This much is indicated in a statement he has given out through an interview printed in the Tombstone Prospector. The latter says: A prospector reporter was admitted to the condemned man's cell today, and Eredia, who is known also as "Chappo," which is Mexican for "Shorty," talked freely, protesting his innocence, and expressed a hope of executive clemency.

The condemned man is a mere youth of 19 years, speaks English fairly well and bears a frank countenance that would not indicate capability of committing such a grave crime as that with which he is charged, the particulars of which are familiar.

Eredia said: "My name is Esperano Eredia, as is also my father, for whom I am named. I am the youngest of five children, and will be 29 years old on the 11th of next September. I have always worked hard, but have led an honest, upright life. Like the majority of young men working in mining camps, have drunk some, yet I never did an act that would injure another, and still I am condemned to die for a murder I never committed. I am innocent. When Mr. Wight was killed I was in bed and the shooting awoke me. My life is dear to me, as I am young and healthy, and desire to live, but I never was a coward, and if there is no remedy, and I must die for this crime I never committed, I can and will die like a man.

"I am told Governor Kibbey is a humane, merciful man, and has said he has no power to commute my sentence, but would do so if he could comply with the law. I pray to God he may see his way clear to save my life."

Eredia paid a high compliment to Sheriff Hunt, the jailer and guards, with whom he found no fault, as they were doing their simple duty. He also felt grateful to his attorney, Thomas Flannigan, for the untiring efforts in his behalf.

Two grief stricken sisters of Eredia call regularly, and the prisoner is much affected by their visits.

The father of Eredia arrived today from Nogales and held a consultation with his son. A death-watch is constantly on guard and every precaution is taken by the jail officials. The jail guards state that Chappo has been a model prisoner during incarceration and has never given the slightest trouble, always deporting himself with gentlemanly demeanor.

## Subway It Again FILLING UP RAPIDLY

LOOKS AS IF ANOTHER CLEANING THIS YEAR WILL LIKELY BE NECESSARY.

That Finished a Few Weeks Ago Cost Above \$3,000, and the Next Will Cost No Less—One Big Rain All That is Necessary.

With the rains that have been had since cleaning the subway was finished early in July, sand and rubbish have been carried in which have filled it to an alarming extent. At the mouth there are several feet of dirt gathered over the tracks which were exposed at the bottom of the waterway at the time the cleaning was finished. Investigation has not been made, but from the condition of things at the mouth of the subway it is presumed that the bend back of the fire house, where filling in the past has been the more rapid and extensive, there are accumulated several more feet of dirt than are in evidence at the mouth. Inspection will probably be made of the subway today to determine this point.
