Weekly Review of Operations

GENERAL RESUME—The week just closed has been a phenomena in the local stock market, and there has been an opportunity for every one to put away a little Christmas money.

The local condition at the several properties in the Bonanza Circle was never better. Development work at the Pittsburg & Duluth and Lake Superior & Pittsburg has been rewarded with increased known ore bodies, and the smelter returns show that the shareholders in these two properties are soon to be enumerated in the dividend class.

Junction, which is still busy with station cutting and the hoisting plant taxed to the utmost in handling the dirt, has refused to be left in the rear, and the week marked an advance of four dollars per share in this stock.

Warren also was among the new beginners to make four or five dollars per share for its stockholders during the week, and there has been plenty of takers at \$19.

The Review in its issue last week was too conservative in its predictions regarding Cochise Development. The six-dollar mark has already been reached, and sales made at \$7.50.

Rumors were in circulation the latter part of the week that holders of the old Cochise stock had dumped the entire lot onto the market.

Indications are now that December will close with Cochise \$2.50 paid stock, selling around the \$15.00 mark.

LATEST ON TONOPAH. Report of Mr. Spurr. Of Practical Value to the Miner and of Interest to the Student.

ON THE RIGHT TRACK AT LAST. (Globe Silver Belt.) One of the most ambitious, and yet feasible propositions brought forth in the history of Globe has just been launched which, if capably managed on the plans now outlined, is morally sure of success—as well based as any that have preceded it that are now in successful operation.

A large group of claims, once famous for the rich silver-lead ores shipped from them, has been connected with another of known value by locating and absorbing intervening ground and 60 claims in all have been incorporated under the title of The Radium Mines Company.

Four miles north of the Old Dominion smelter on a direct line towards Hamilton basin these claims traverse a section of country from one to two miles in width, north to south, and nearly four miles from Pinal creek eastward.

Nothing more modern than a hand windlass was ever used on any shaft in these properties and scarcely a stick of timber was placed in the numerous tunnel openings which were necessarily primitive affairs.

It has long been a matter of wonderment that the claims which produced so much high grade silver ore in the days of the early excitement in this district, should be neglected in the same condition as the original operators left them.

On the properties of the Old Dominion company and the Copper Hill mines, now immense producers of copper since depth has been obtained in the workings, silver and lead ores carrying high values were produced in the early days and from this beginning the Globe camp grew to its present proportions.

Copper came to the front and after many years of unprofitable effort by other companies, the Old Dominion's smelter and concentrating plants have been put in successful operation, serving as an object lesson to demonstrate what capital and judgment combined can accomplish.
