SPokane, Feb. 27.—A witness today testified that he had seen Dr. Thaw at the residence of the late Mrs. Thaw.

He described the means by which he got to Denver where he met Jack Shupples, who was then a member of the executive committee of the Western Federation.

When he went into the Marble Creek district he was armed with an old black powder Winchester rifle and an automatic revolver.

He described the manner of his arrest at his uncle's ranch near Baker City on a warrant charging him with complicity in the Steuermann assassination.

He said that while at the depot waiting for the train Sheriff Brown told him that he was on the inside, and if Adams would do what he wanted, he would come out all right.
